Children entering Grade 1 have the option of enrolling in one of two programs. Please check the option you prefer for your child:

Grade 1 English Prime leading to Pre-Intensive French in Grade 4 and Intensive French in Grade 5
(Offered in all schools)

- Students will be exposed to French culture in Grade 3.
- In Grade 4 students receive 150 minutes per week of Pre-Intensive French.
- In Grade 5 students will spend 3 to 4 hours per day receiving French instruction (oral, reading and writing) for 5 months, followed by 200 minutes per week of French instruction for the remainder of the year.
- Students will have an option to enter Late Immersion in grade 6.

OR

Grade 1 French Immersion
(Offered where numbers warrant)

- Students will receive 90 - 100% of instruction in French.
- The vast majority of subjects will be delivered in French.
- English Language Arts instruction will begin in Grade 3.

Children entering Grade 6 have the option of enrolling in one of two programs. Please check the option you prefer for your child:

Grade 6 English Prime with Post-Intensive French
(Offered in all middle schools)

- Post-Intensive French - Grades 6 - 10**
- Grades 6 to 8 (200 minutes per week)
 - Grades 9 and 10 (1 course per year)
 - Grade 11 and 12 – French is optional

OR

Grade 6 Late French Immersion
(Offered where numbers warrant)

- Late French Immersion - Beginning in Grade 6**
- Grades 6 to 8 (70% of instruction in French)
 - Grades 9 and 10 (50% of instruction in French)*
 - Grades 11 and 12 (25% of instruction in French)

* Schools may elect to offer either 70% French instruction in Grade 9 and 30% in Grade 10, or 50% in each of Grades 9 and 10.
