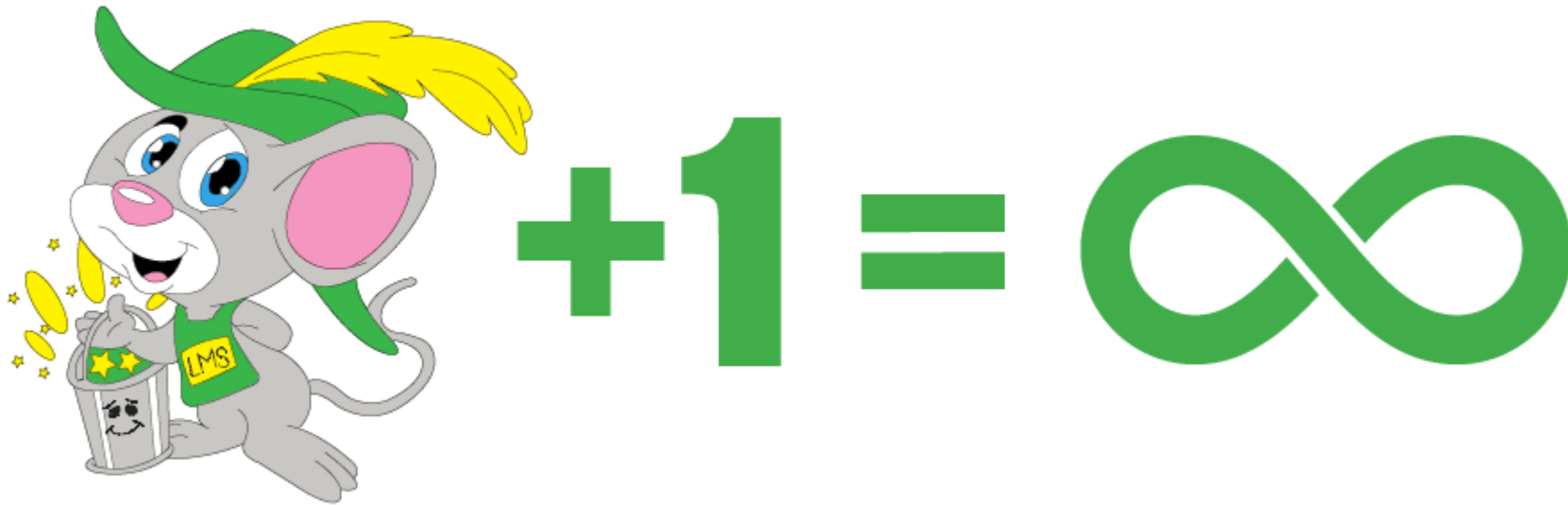

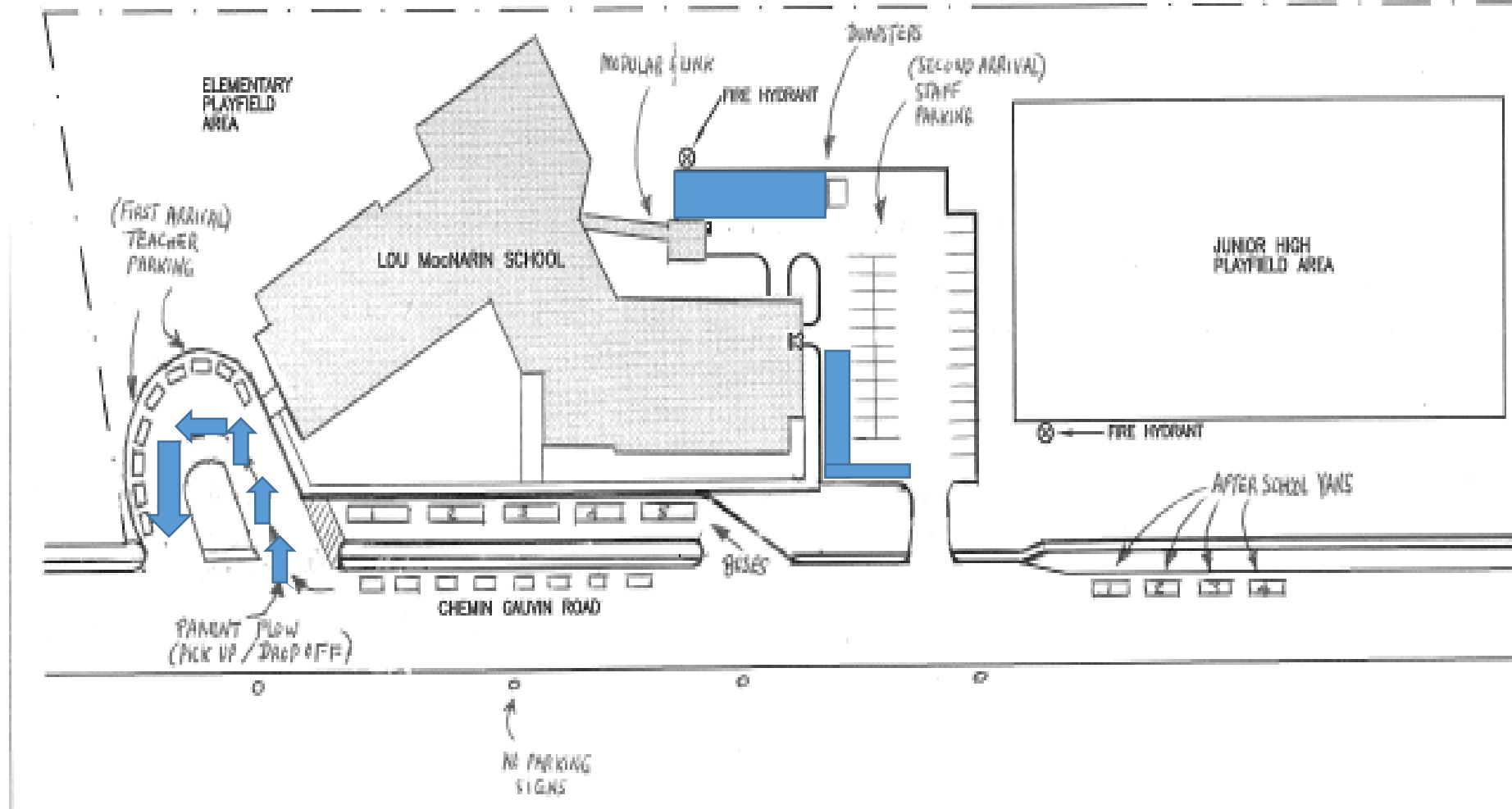

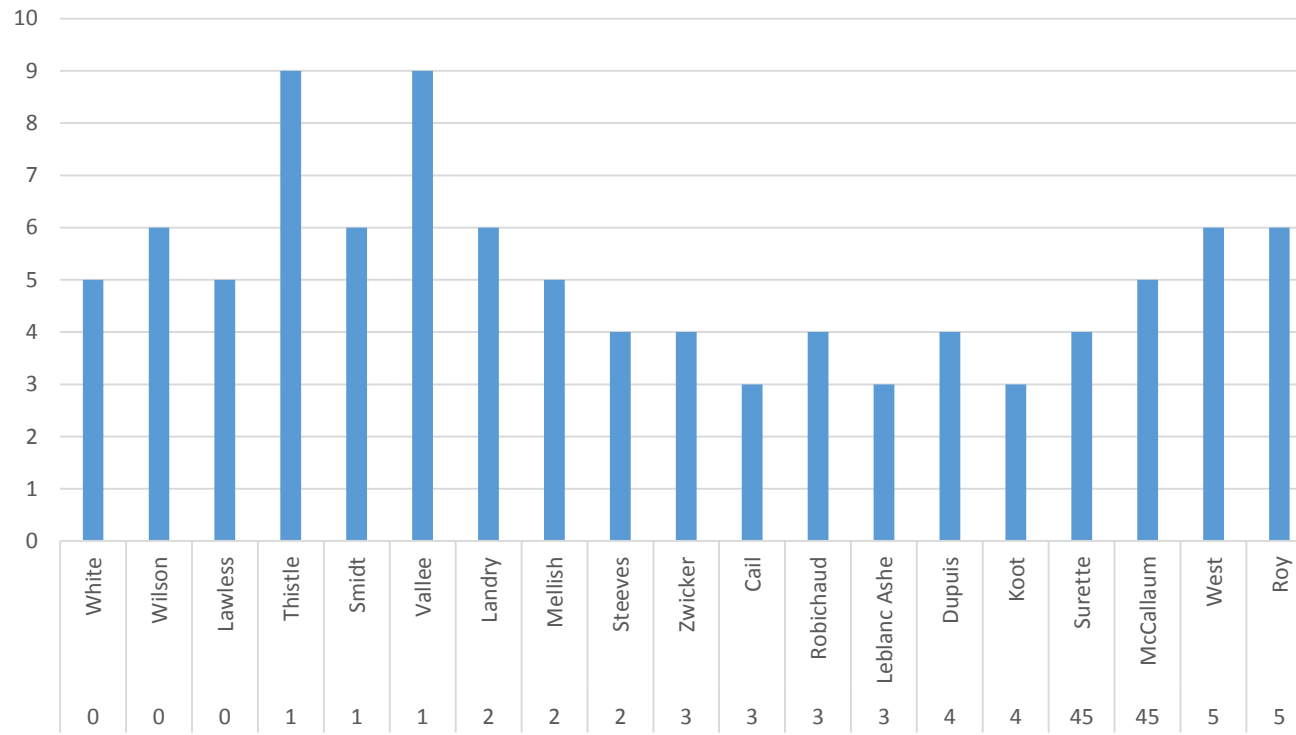

# Divide Pick up Zone areas

- Kindergarten – move to east side of the building for pick up outside of the cafeteria door.
- Grade 5 students will be picked up here as well.
- Investigate how many daycare vehicles are using the pick up zone and assign parking along the sidewalk/Social club door

# September 2016

- Paint a solid line dividing the drive through area in half.
- Inside lane designated for parking during afterschool pick up.
- Outside lane designated as driving lane for parked cars to exit.
- Cars that cannot fit in the parking lane must park across the street in the sub division.
- Parents must wait for children in the blue parking spots and take their children to their cars.
- Children are not permitted to walk across the pick up zone unattended by a parent/guardian

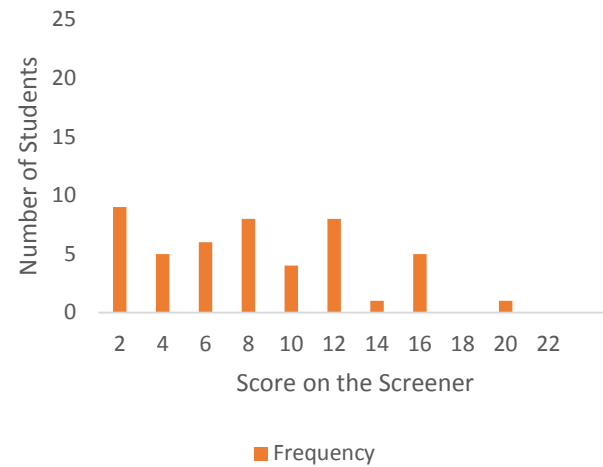

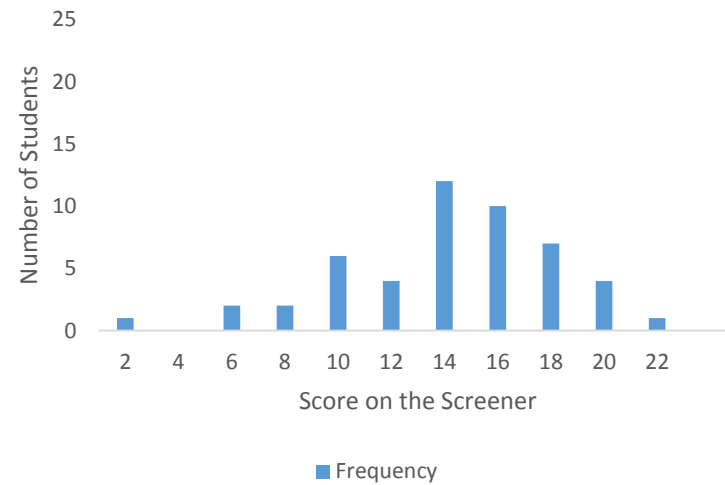

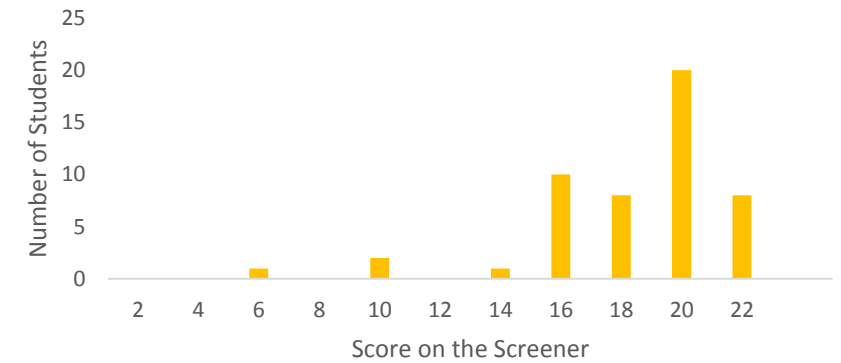
Kindergarten Math Screener

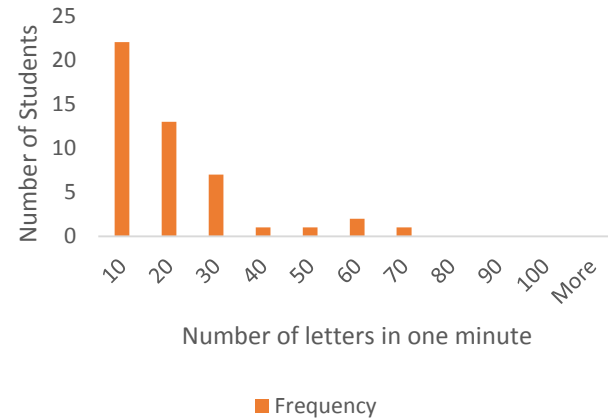


Kindergarten Math Screener June 2016

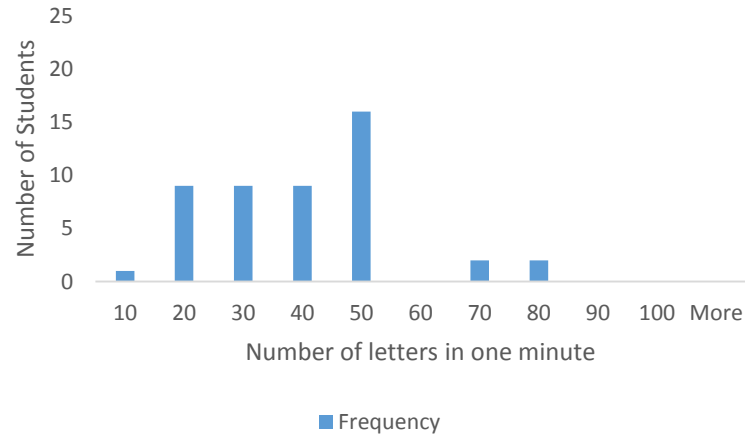

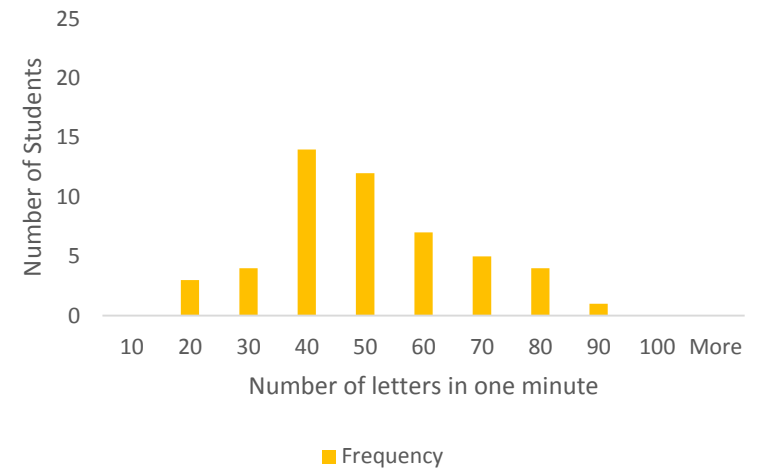
Kindergarten Letter Naming

Kindergarten Letter Naming March 2016

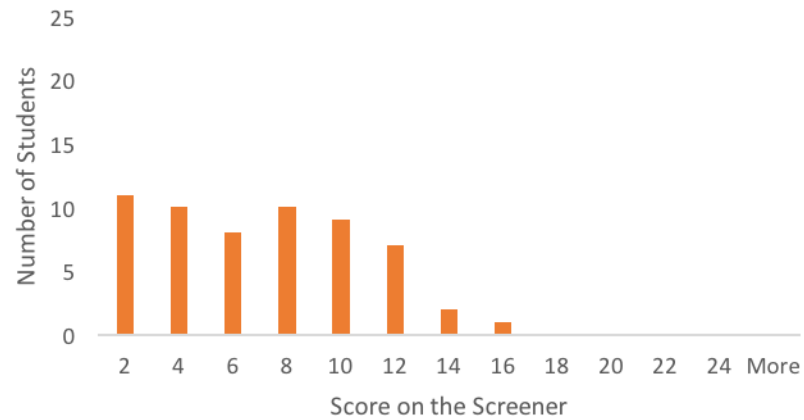

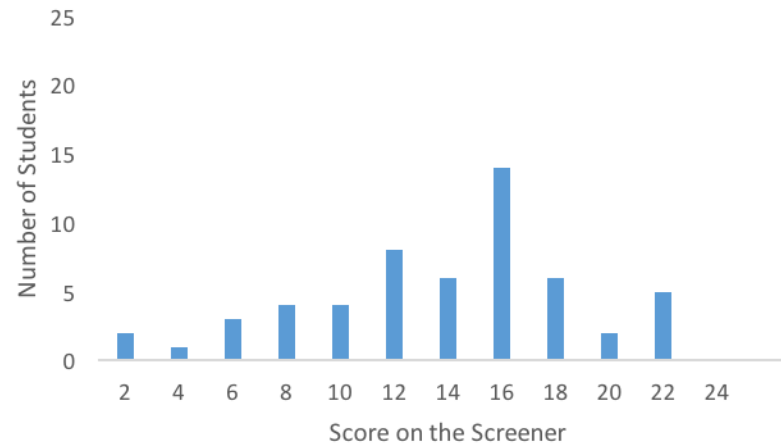

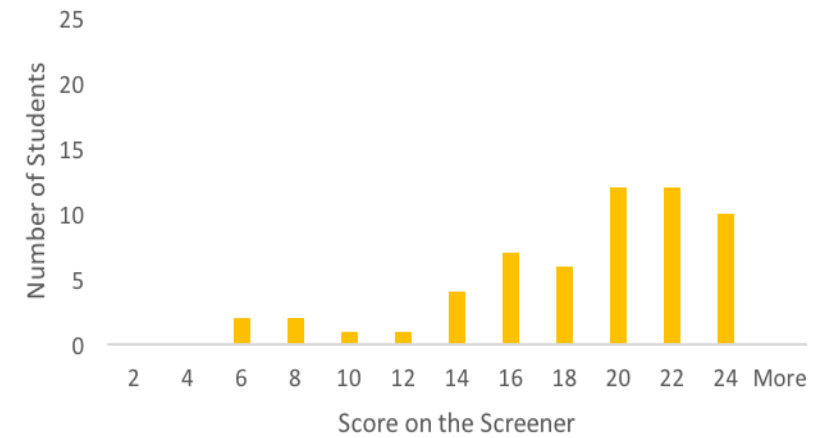
Grade 1 Math Screener September 2015



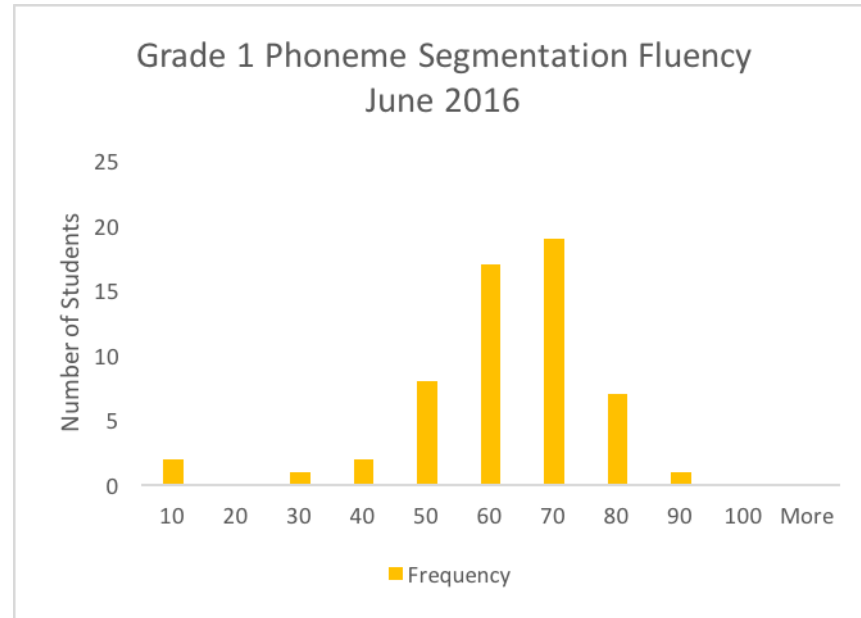
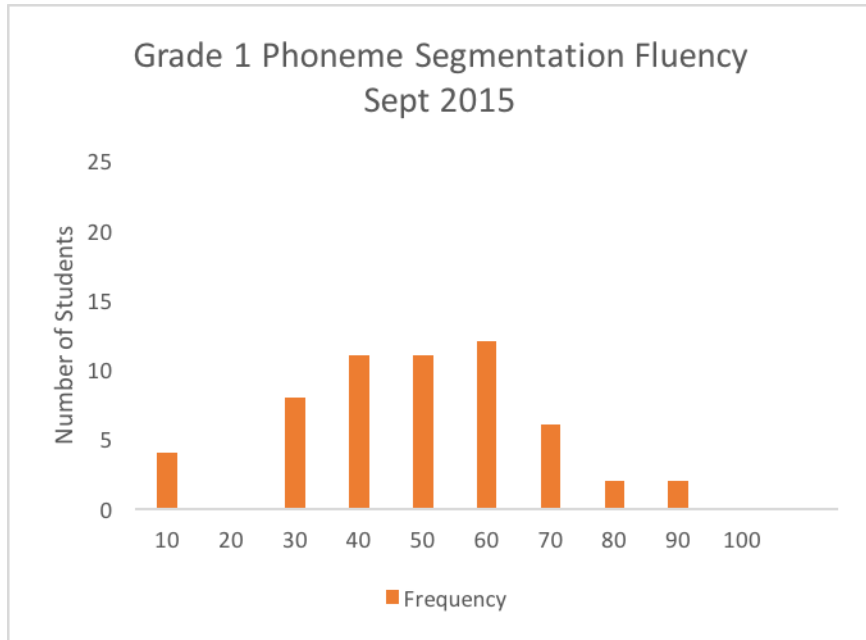
Grade 1 Math Screener March 2016

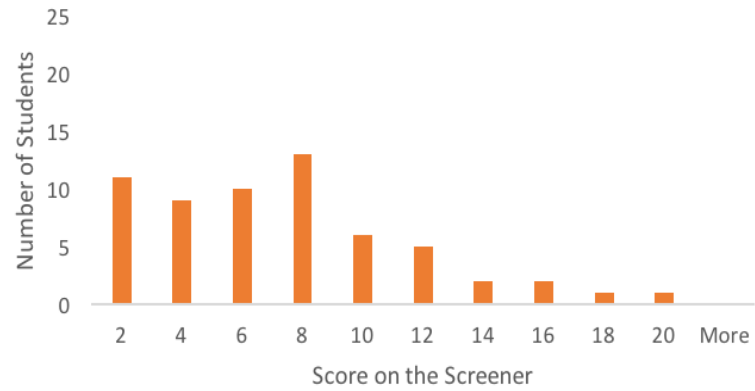

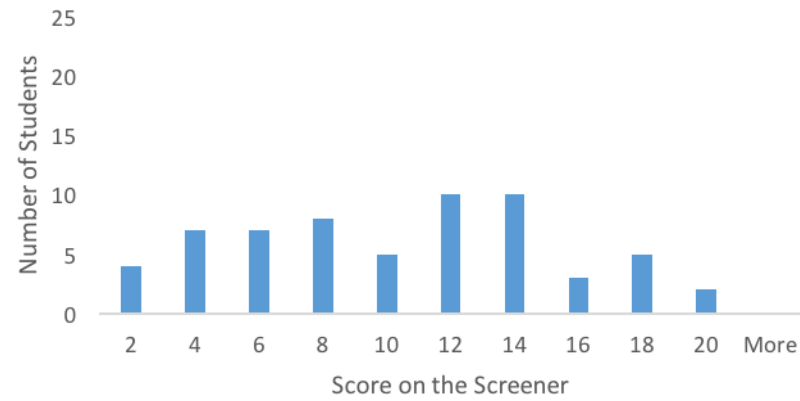

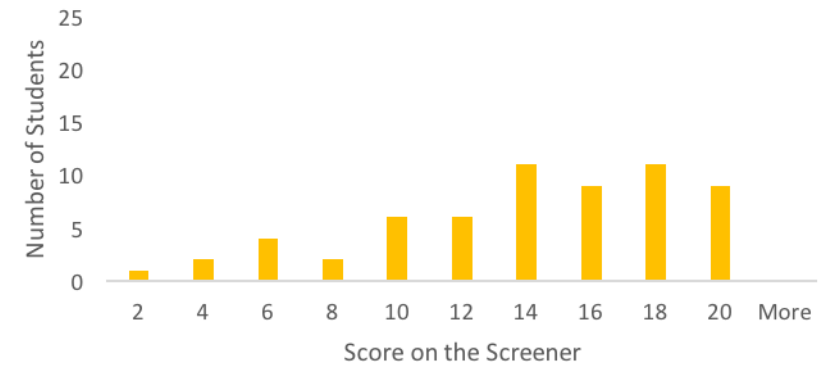
Grade 2 Math Screener September 2015

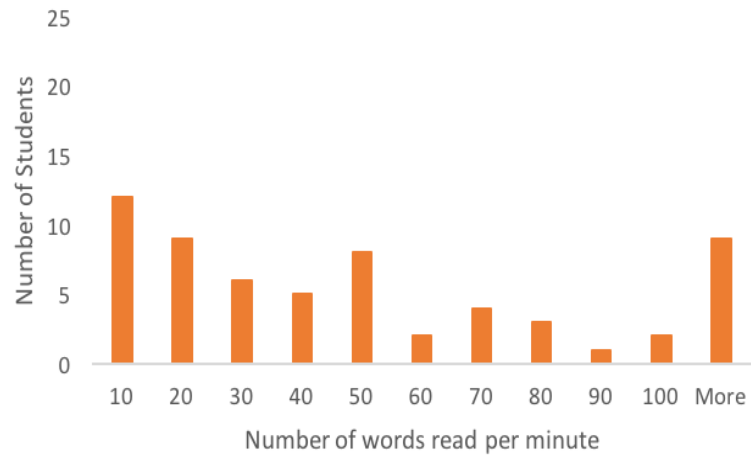


Grade 2 Math Screener June

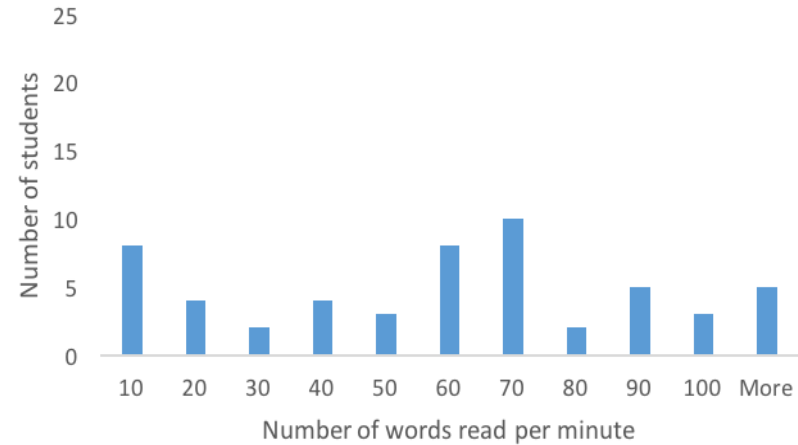

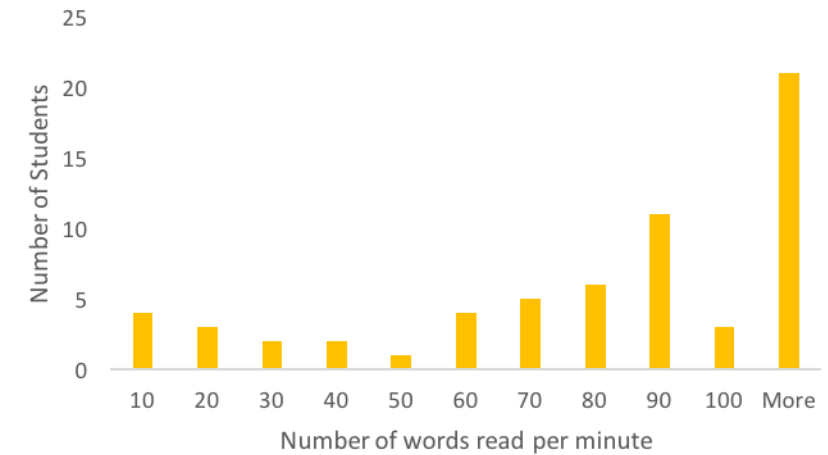
Grade 2 Aimsweb September 2015



Grade 2 Aimsweb March 2016

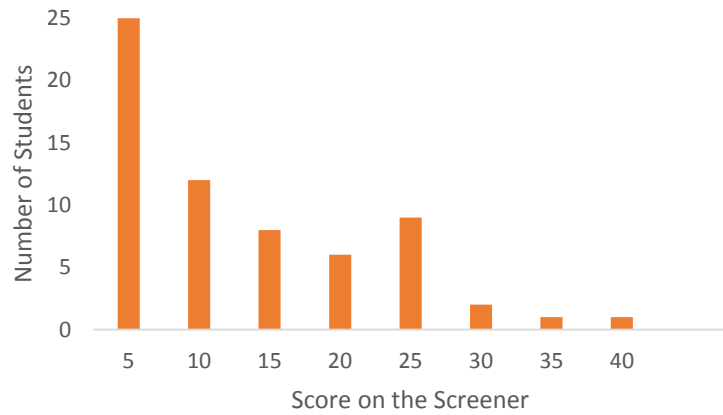

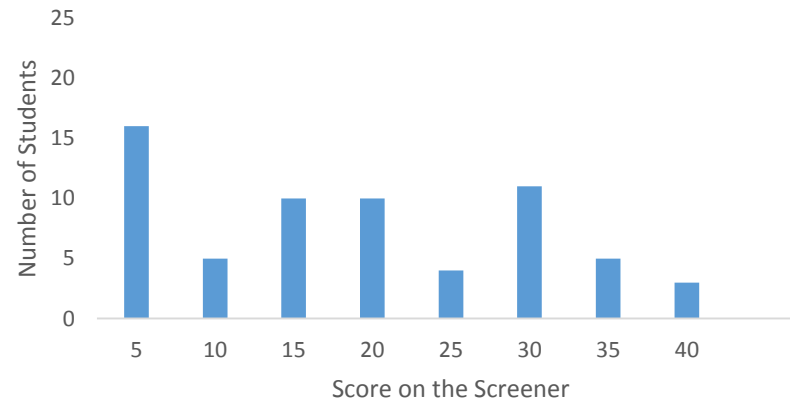

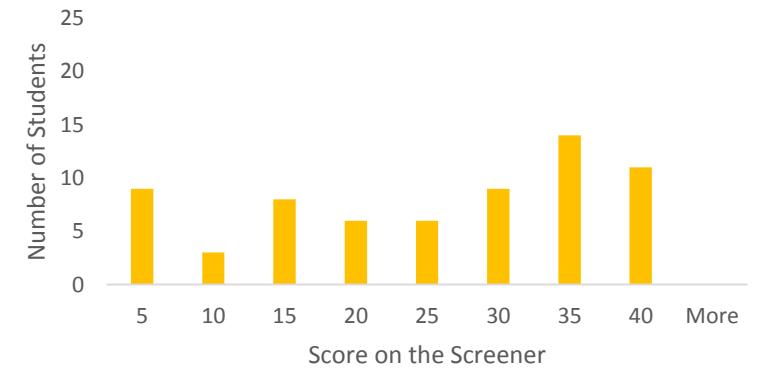
Grade 3 Math Screener September 2015

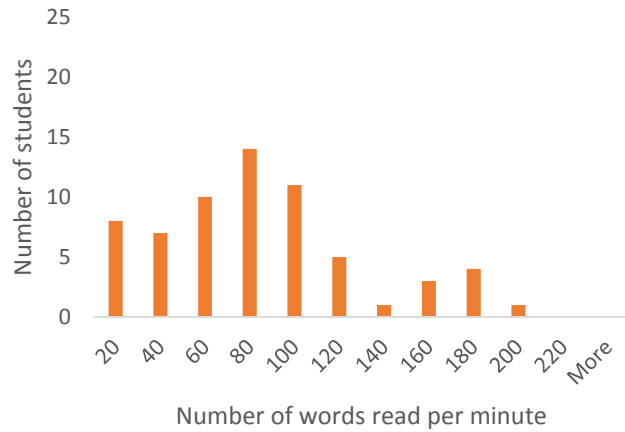


Grade 3 Math Screener June 2016

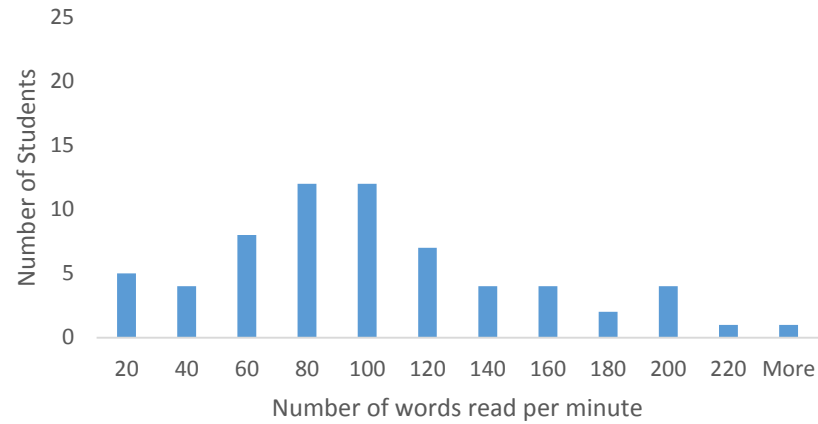

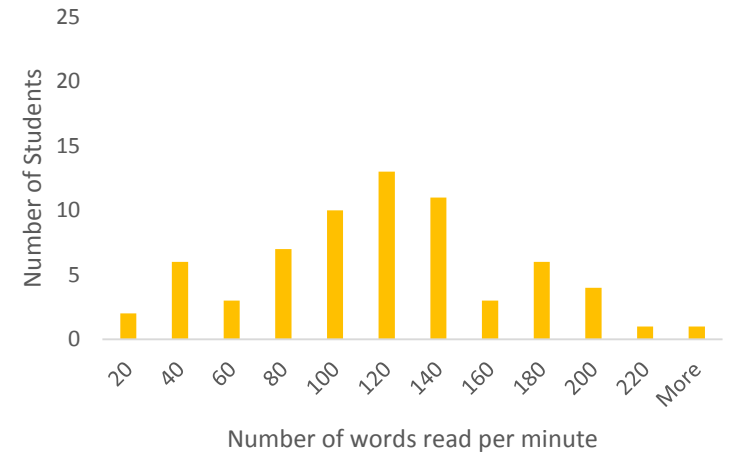
Grade 3 Aimsweb September 2015



Grade 3 Aimsweb March 2016



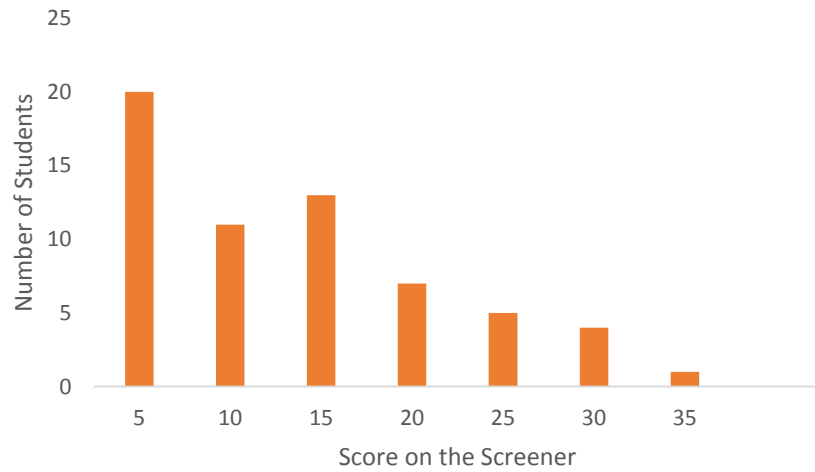
Grade 3 Aimsweb June 2016



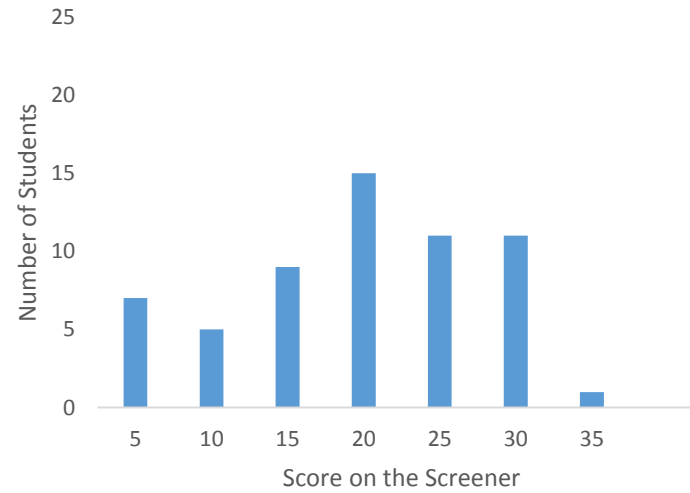

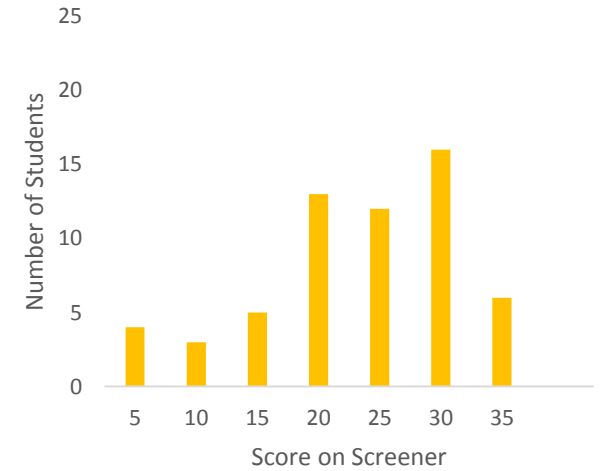
Grade 4 Math Screener September 2015



Grade 4 Math Screener March 2016

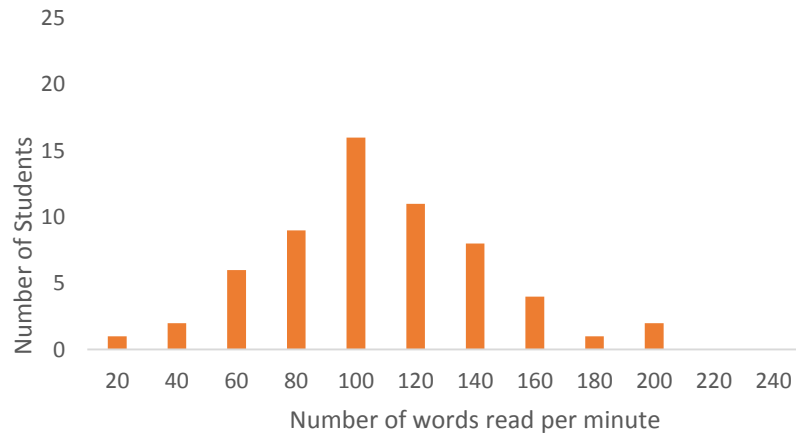


Grade 4 Math Screener June 2016

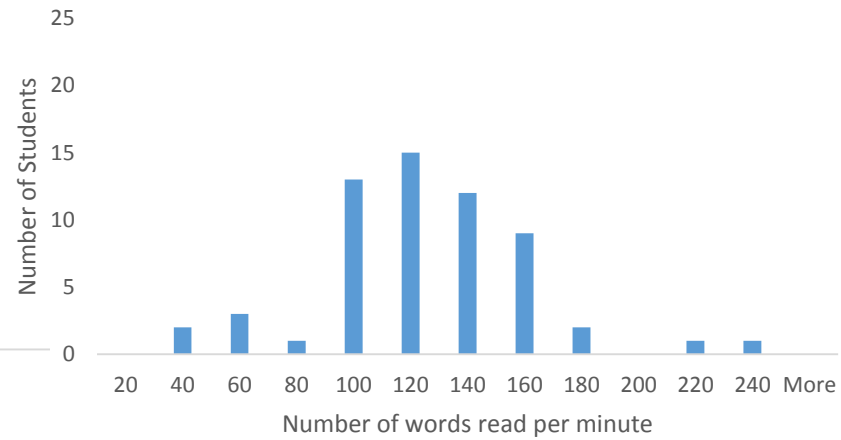

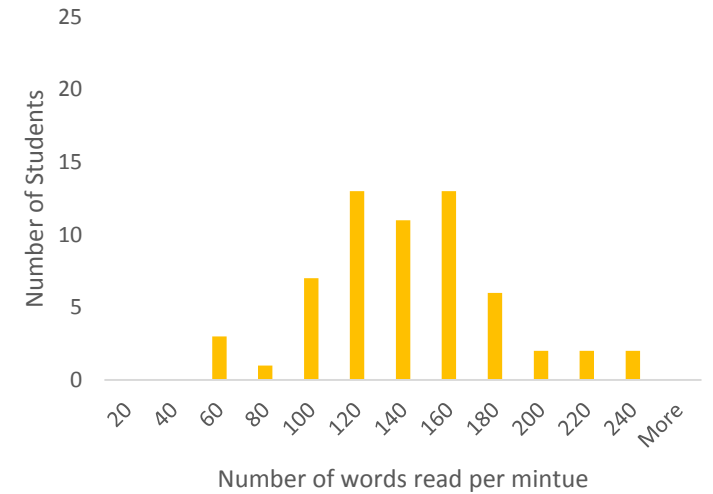
Grade 4 Aimsweb September 2015

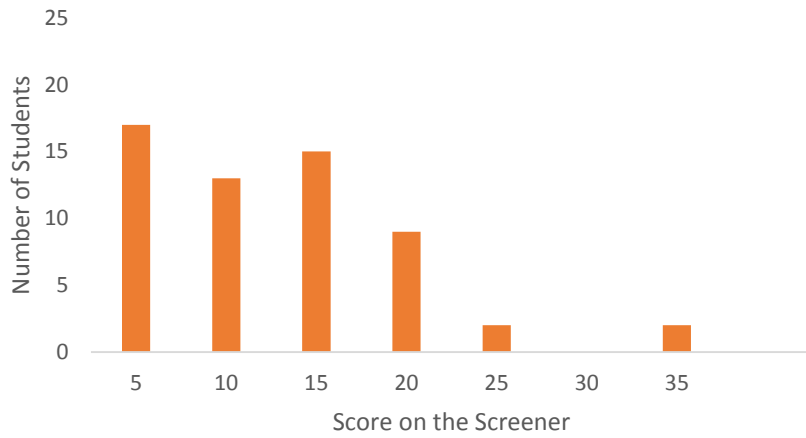

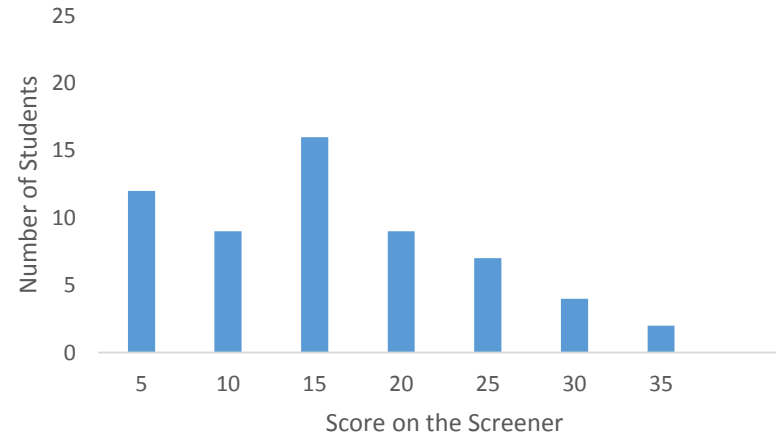

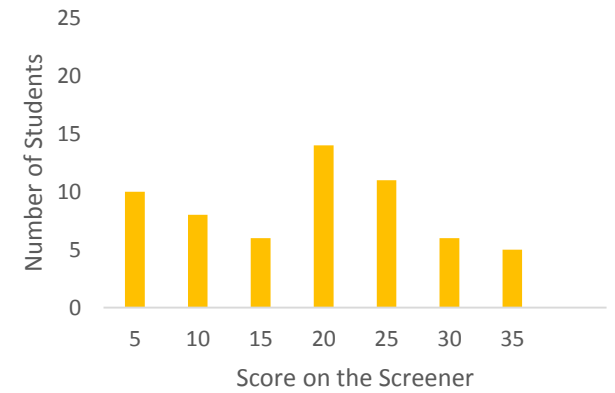
Grade 5 Math Screener September 2015



Grade 5 Math Screener March 2016

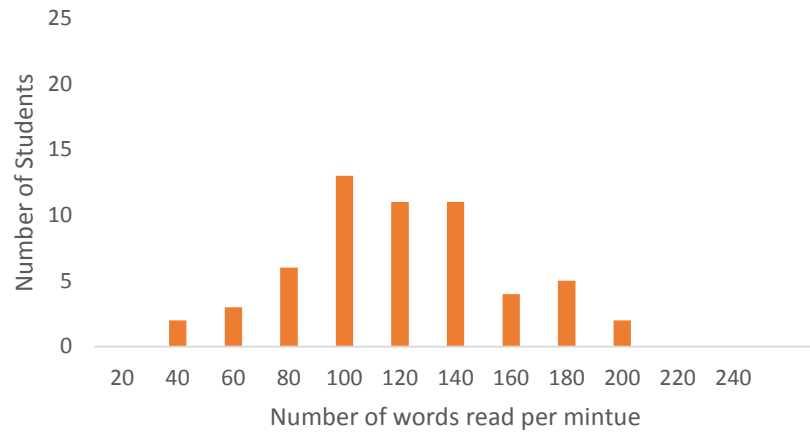


Grade 5 Math Screener June 2016

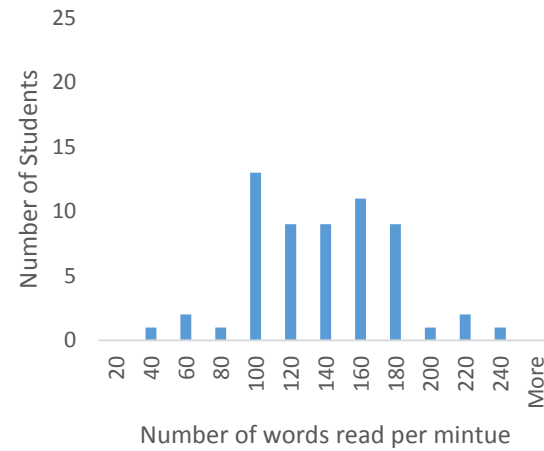

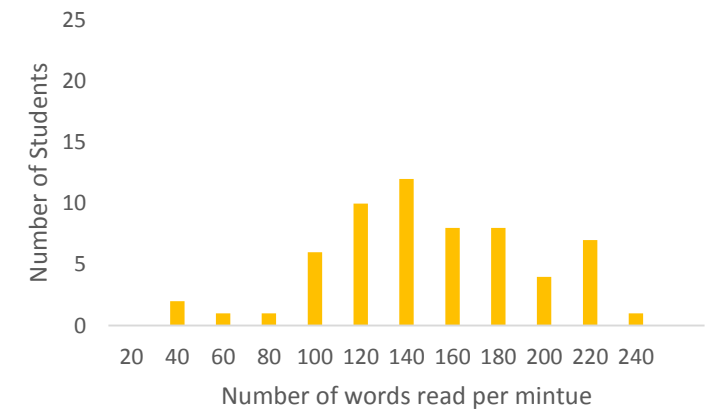
Grade 5 Aimsweb September 2015



Grade 5 Aimsweb March 2016

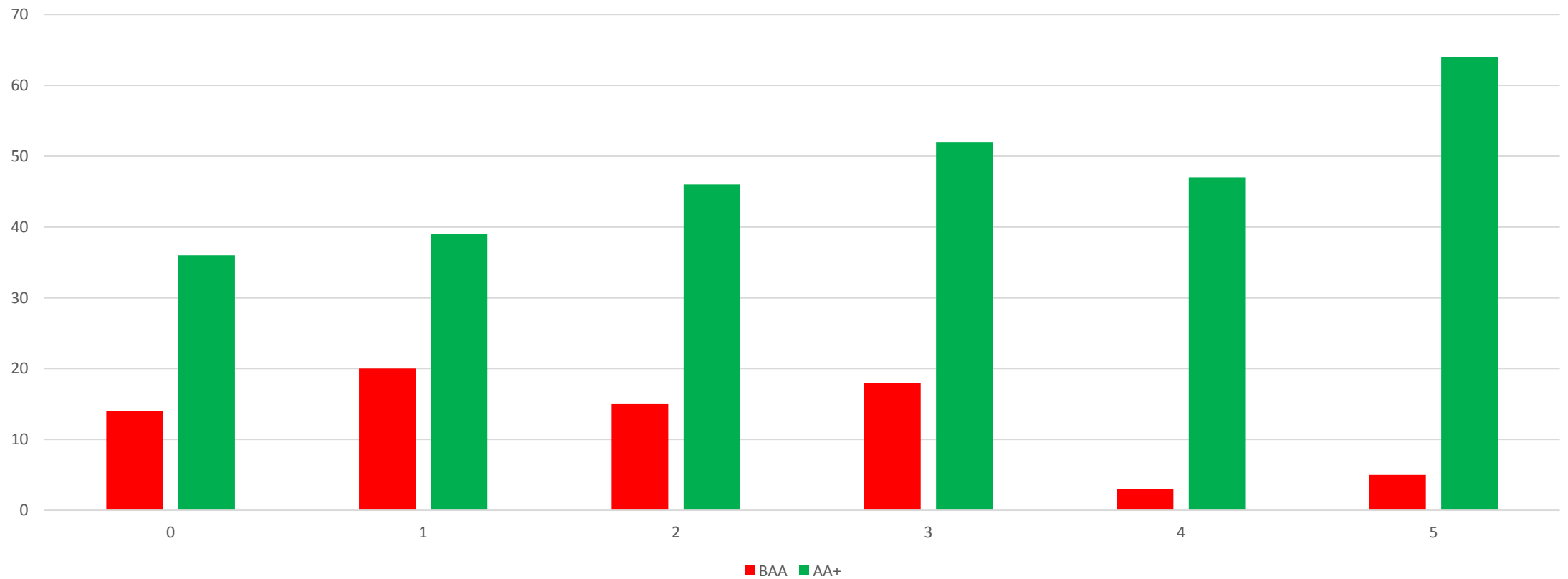


Grade 5 Aimsweb June 2016



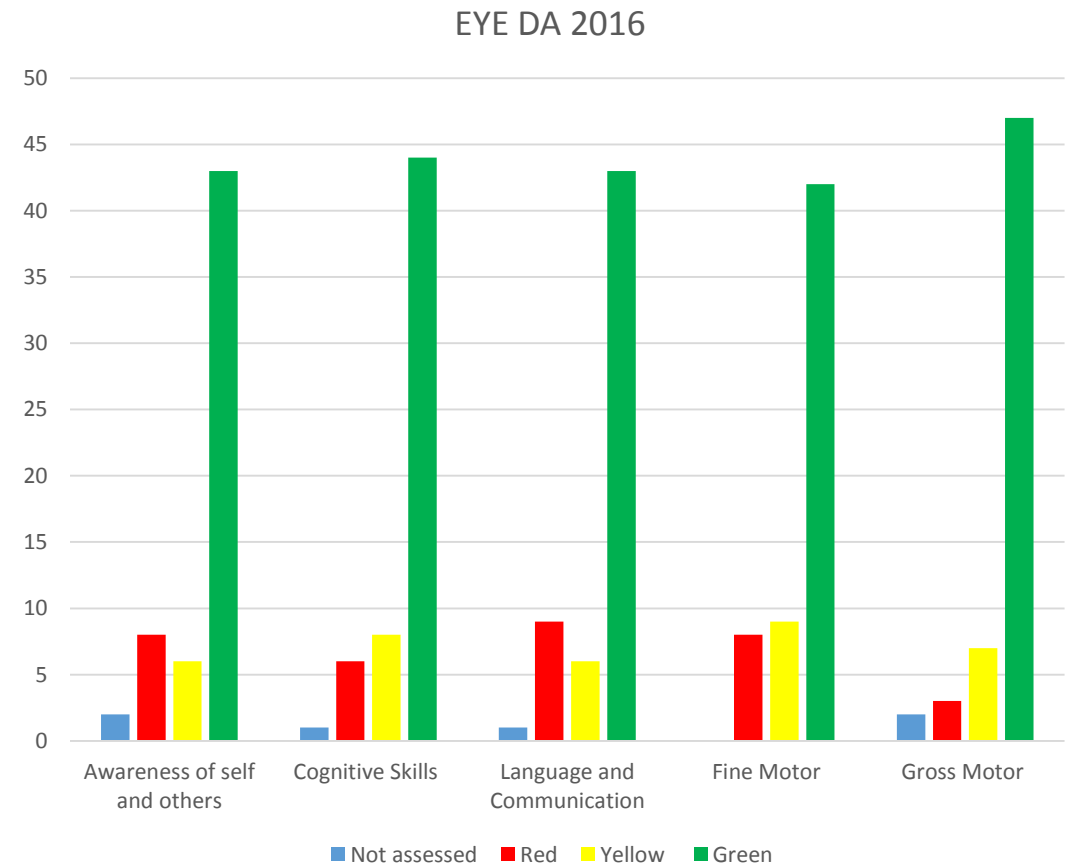
