Anglophone East School District/Moncton High School Mobile Computing Discipline Plan

Minor Offenses

- Illegal installation or transmission of copyrighted materials
- Unauthorized use of Internet or computer games
- Downloading inappropriate materials
- Students are not allowed to give out personal information, for any reason, over the Internet.

The district and/or school can use any of the following disciplinary consequences when addressing minor offenses, while taking into consideration the nature of the incident and prior technology offenses:

1. Student meeting with parents conducted by the classroom teacher.
2. In school suspension
3. Loss of privilege to bring the Mobile Computing Device home.

Major Offenses

- Action violating existing district/provincial policy, public law or Policy 311, etc
- Removing district applications and changing of personal mobile computing device settings (exceptions include personal settings such as font size, brightness, etc.)
- Sending, transmitting, accessing, uploading, downloading, or distributing obscene, offensive, profane, threatening, pornographic or sexually explicit materials
- Use sites selling term papers, book reports and other forms of student work spamming (disruptive email or messages)
- Gaining access to another student's accounts, files and/or data
- Use of the school's Internet or email accounts for financial gain, commercial gain or any illegal activity.
- Vandalism (any malicious attempt to harm or destroy mobile computing device)

- Bypassing the Anglophone East School District internet filtering through a Web proxy

Major Offenses may be addressed as follows:

- First Offense: School Administration communicated with the parents/guardians.
Second Offense: Student will no longer bring the Mobile Computing Device home.
Third Offense: Student will no longer have access to a Mobile Computer Device.
Student will only have access to desktop computer located in the library or computer lab.

The administration reserves the right to handle any of the above actions or any other action determined to be misuse of technology in the manner they feel is the most appropriate for all concerned. APPENDIX A:

Student/Parent pledge for use of the mobile computing device

1. I will take proper care of the mobile computing device.
2. I will not loan the mobile computing device, charger and cords to others.
3. I will be accountable for the mobile computing device at all times.
4. I will charge the mobile computing device's battery daily.
5. I will not leave the mobile computing device in an unlocked vehicle.
6. I will keep food and beverages away from the mobile computing device.
7. I will not disassemble any part of the mobile computing device nor attempt repairs.
8. I will protect the mobile computing device by carrying it in the case provided.
9. I will not stack objects on top of the mobile computing device.
10. I will not leave the mobile computing device outside or use it near water.

11. I will save data to the network directory. (Anglophone East School District will at times re-sync mobile computing devices. All files not saved to server or other storage media will be deleted during these processes. Students are ultimately responsible for saving all their personal files.)
12. I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markings, etc.) on the mobile computing device or district-issued protective case. I will not deface the serial number, manufacturer labels or district labels on any mobile computing device.
13. I will follow district policies outlined in the Mobile Computing Guide and the district's Acceptable Use Policy.
14. I will file a police report in case of theft, vandalism or other misuse.
15. I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse.
16. I agree to return the mobile computing device, case and power cords in good working order.

I agree to the stipulations set forth in the Mobile Computing Guide, Anglophone East School District Acceptable Use Policy and the Student Pledge for Use of the Mobile Computing Device. I understand my mobile computing device is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of Anglophone East School District.
