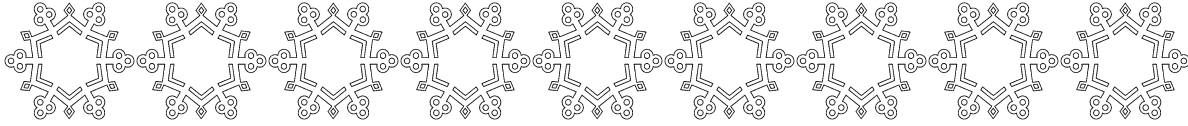


Operation Snow Pile
