Under the NB Teachers' Collective Agreement, all Kindergarten to Grade 8 teachers are to receive two half days each year for report card preparation. On March 15 the Kindergarten to grade 8 teachers were scheduled to have another half day to help with their preparation of the March 2018 Report Cards.
