## Roots of Empathy at AES

A Baby Teacher in the Classroom?

Yes! Once again, there is a baby visiting the grade 3 classroom at AES each month as part of the Roots of Empathy program. During these visits the students have the opportunity to observe the growth and development of “their” classroom baby, Genevieve, during her first year of life.



Empathy is being able to understand how another person feels. Roots of Empathy focuses on teaching “emotional literacy”, the ability to identify and label feelings, as a building block for respectful and caring relationships.

Studies have shown that bullying behaviour decreases and respect and kindness increases in classes and schools where empathy and emotional literacy have been taught.
