Another initiative we are implementing is in the area of school wide behavior expectations. After a school wide assembly, it was decided that we would focus on the 3 Rs of behavior - responsibility, respect, and reliability. Beginning with responsibility, students and staff have been talking about what it means to be responsible and how to put that into our day-to-day practices in school and beyond. We repeat a pledge each morning to help everyone remember the lessons .of responsibility and move on to put it into practice in our words and actions.
