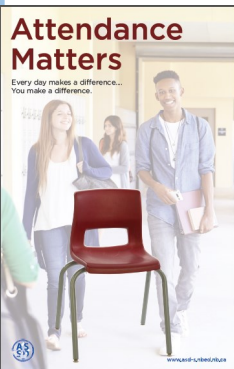
Thank you to Mrs. Cameron for knitting mittens and hats to restock our supply. Miss Myers has made some lovely warm hats for our students as well.
