

**Norton Elementary School Kindergarten School Supply List 2017-2018**

- 2 Large Glue Sticks (UHV-yellow or Elmer’s work best)
- 4 Duo Tangs
- 1 Box of Crayola Crayons
- 1 Pair of Blunt End Scissors

*Non Instructional Items:*

- 1 pair indoor sneakers with non-marking soles (Velcro preferred unless your child can tie/untie independently)
- Book Bag and Lunchbox
- Complete change of clothes in plastic bag with name clearly marked (For spills, illness, getting wet outside, etc.)
- 1 package of plastic spoons
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- Additional items if you wish to make a donation to the school: plastic spoons/forks, extra Kleenex, baby wipes, large or extra-large “Ziploc” bags, extra dry-erase markers

**If you are unable to find the exact items on the list, items that are similar are sufficient.**

Due to the generosity of local community groups, kindergarten parents will not need to purchase the following this year: pencils, construction paper, and loose leaf.

Children’s supplies are shared and distributed as needed. We ask that you put your child’s name on the following only: sneakers, book bags, lunch bags and clothing (including jackets, hats, snow pants, and change of clothing).

***You do not need to send all your child’s school supplies on the first day of school.***
