Garneau was appointed an Officer of the <u>Order of Canada</u> in 1984 in recognition of his role as the first Canadian astronaut. He was promoted the rank of Companion within the order in 2003 for his extensive work with Canada's space program.

He was awarded the <u>Canadian Forces Decoration</u> for 12 years of honourable service with the <u>Canadian</u> Forces.

He is honoured with a high school named after him, <u>Marc Garneau Collegiate Institute</u> in Toronto and É.S.P. <i>Marc-Garneau in <u>Trenton, Ontario</u>.

Garneau is the Honorary Captain of the <u>Royal Canadian Sea Cadets</u>. In addition, n° 599 <u>Royal Canadian Air</u> <u>Cadets</u> squadron is named in his honour.
