Construction Zone at SES



There are currently work projects going on at Sussex Elementary. The first project involves the construction of a building to hold a biomass fuel burning system for heating purposes. The building should be up prior to Christmas and the project is scheduled to finish near the end of March. In

addition to the building a 40ft. high pellet storage hopper will also be installed. You can see from the photo where the building will sit.



A second project that is being completed by the Town of Sussex is an upgrade of the water line that runs from the school on up through the cemetery. This water line is very old and needs to be replaced. With today's technology the new line will be installed adjacent to the old one using directional drilling technology. This means the only digging is what you see in the picture.
