The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved.

Arising from the minutes was the position of Vice-Chair, Jodi Ravn was nominated and she accepted the position.

PSSC Budget remains the same at 1061.94 which pays for Synervoice. It cost roughly \$2.50 per child for Synervoice but it is used for many areas of communication between the school and home.,

Discussion was focused on the Volunteer Initiative. It was discussed how to start the program, who should be a part of the program? Should it be parents alone? The community as a whole? Businesses?

The following are areas of need

- 1. Reading :currently the main demand is reading to students which would be 1/2 hour of a person's time.
- 2. Noon hour Clubs: 20 minutes of someone's time. This can consist of the gym or kids coming together to play lego, board games, sports. It is really the kids that choose what kind a club to have. The times that require someone to monitor the kids would be as follows: 11:40-12:10 and 12:10-12:40. The demand may mean 3-5 adult supervision.

School Improvement Plan: Nov 30, 2012 was a PD day and the focused on Literacy. They looked at the standards for writing per grade level on provincial level. There was a round table discussion on how parents are clueless how to help students in
