April Minutes approved as presented.

- 1. School Supply Fees
 - Due to management and projected costs, the school decided it would be difficult to implement the school supply fees for grades 3-5.
 - The K-2 fees will go ahead with the following a \$30 dollar fee for all students, that will include the agenda book.
 - A discussion ensued regarding the necessity of the agenda book in relation to the \$5 dollar cost and its usage. We agreed to look at this in the fall.
- 2. SES School Improvement Plan
 - Priority Development Unit update
 - SES will have the same ratio of numeracy and literacy leads as this year. However, the delivery model may be in a block format. (ie; 6 weeks)
 - Powerschool training and new provincial report card. The school has started PD development on the new reporting system which is based on effective formative assessment practices. Parents will be receiving more information in June report card envelope at the end of this year.
- 3. PSSC 2016-17 Goals
 - ASD-S homework policy and SES homework parameters have been reviewed with SES staff.
- 4. Staffing 2017-2018
 - 24 Homerooms (8 FI)
 - Support Staff (21 EA's plus 1 Behavior Interventionist)
 - Additional support from new Teacher Collective Agreement. SES received an additional allocation of .3 from these additional FTE allocated through the new collective agreement.
- 5. Meet the Teacher Evening Sept. Possibly Speaker on Mental Health
 - Agreed not to combine the 2 events. Meet the Teacher on Sept. 14th and Guest Speaker on Sept. 28th. Doug will contact 2 potential presenters on

the topic. Perhaps parents can sign up on the 14th and then we could offer free supper for the mental health evening.
