- Please arrive during your designated time looking amazing with your gown, cap, tassel & stoles on!
- Vehicles are asked to travel via Bryant Drive to Kennedy Drive turning left into the bus lane at SRHS (the wrong way). See attached map. Thank you for your patience as you wait your turn. As Principal Lauridsen stated in the video, **please ensure your vehicle does not block the entrances and exits** to the parking lots for Extra-Mural or the Health Centre.
- When the vehicle you are travelling in arrives at the designated spot (this will be clear when you drive up) you will exit your vehicle and wait in line. There will be markers on the ground to show you where to stand as you march so that we maintain 6 feet for social distancing purposes.
