



G3's role within our school

is three-fold. The first role is the connection created and provided within a core group of students with an advisor twice a week for four years. Secondly, G3 provides a space for important school communication and information such as course selection process, graduation information and school wide guest speakers. Thirdly, curriculum is covered to allow for students to receive a credit from this time in their final year of high school. Attendance in G3 is required like any other class and marks are updated in Brightspace as well as on the PS Portal. This year our facilitator, Mr. Gaunce, has provided assignments that are meant to provide students with a chance to practice the outcomes of the course as well as reflect on the skills that the course is designed around, such as goal setting, study habits, career research, time management, perseverance, etc. All skills that will hopefully make life easier in high school and after graduation. Students were reminded, as in any classroom or course at SRHS, that if they have questions or concerns with in G3, please direct them to your advisor, Mr. Gaunce or Mrs. Lauridsen.



Connection, Reconnection and Being Involved

allows our students to become a part of SRHS. We encourage active participation in our classrooms, clubs, activities, and athletics.

Good attendance

requires students to be in class, seated and ready to participate when the final bell sounds. Families are asked to provide excuses for known absences by providing a written note, emailing or calling the school. Chronic tardies and absences will be addressed by G3 teacher notifying home after 5 absences and administration will connect with families and student to discuss a plan if 10 or more absences are reached. If students are tardy or truant, teachers will hold students accountable.

Knowing their Academic Progress

allows a student to understand how well they are doing in each class. Teachers provide feedback on their learning in various ways so it is essential that all work assigned is completed. Using the PS Parent Portal will allow students and families to stay updated in each course as marks are updated by teachers regularly.
