Focus on Information Technology (FIT) Program is a Canada wide Certificate from the Information and Communications Technology Council (ICTC). FIT provides students with the opportunity to develop technology and business/entrepreneurial skills with essential workplace skills and experience.

All students who achieve a FIT certificate are required to have two foundation courses. These courses are:

- Information Technology 120
- Business Organization and Management 120

To achieve a certificate students need the two foundation courses plus one additional course from the stream below.

Students can achieve a FIT Certificate in one or more of the following streams:

- Business and Information Analysis (Entrepreneurship 110)
- Software Design and Development (Computer Science 110) Available in 2016-2017
- Network and Systems Operations (Technical Support 110)
- Interactive Media (Digital Productions 120)
