- > Exams will be written the week of June 10-14.
- > All graduation events are school activities and therefore school rules apply.
- Basic graduation fee of \$60.00 prior to May.10, after May 10 \$65.00 must be paid by all graduates. This fee covers many items including the cost of diploma covers, cap, tassel, dry cleaning gowns, programs, invitations, rink rental, set up of stage and chairs, postage for transcripts, etc.
- All fees associated with graduation will be collected in the lobby by Grad Class members on the following dates, beginning May.1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> from 12:35-1:05pm (Receipts provided) or on school cash net.
- Any student, who will not graduate, will be notified by Principal Lauridsen on the morning of Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup>.

- Graduates that are attending post-secondary institutions in the fall are reminded that it is necessary to complete the "transcript request" form in the school office in order for their final marks to be sent to the college/university they have chosen to attend.

  - Graduates and parents are encouraged to attend this church service.
  - Recommended dress is semi-formal/ business causal: This would be similar to how you would dress for a class presentation. Comfortable shoes are recommended as students march from SRHS to the church.
  - o Students should be at the school by 5:45 p.m.to allow time for the grad march through town.
- ★ Graduation Prom 8 10:00 p.m. June 18<sup>th</sup>, SRHS Cost \$15/Grad (\$20 non grad guest) Each graduate will be given 4 tickets to go in the gymnasium
  - $\circ~$  Graduates are to meet at the 8th Hussars at 6:00 p.m. for a group photo.
  - Graduates are to arrive at the school before 7:45 p.m.
- ★ Grad Dinner 7 p.m. May. 30<sup>th</sup>, All Seasons Inn Cost **\$30/Grad** –Grads are invited to attend a banquet at the All Seasons Inn, meal will consist of a Canadian/Chinese Buffet.
- ★ Graduation rehearsal 10 a.m. June 20<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>TH</sup> Hussars Sports Centre.
  - Students will be shown how to enter the rink, how to receive their diploma and practice the process.
    It is very important that all grads attend so that they are aware of the details of the graduation night process.

Graduates should arrive at the school at 5:30 p.m. to have their cap and gown fitted by teachers and parent volunteers. Dress is formal for graduation, with gentlemen wearing white shirts and a dark or red tie, dark pants and shoes. Ladies wear should be a white shirt or blouse, dark pants or skirt and dark shoes.
  - After graduation, gowns are to be returned to the school.
