Applications do not open until late May or June (you cannot do anything with student loans before then)



There will be an announcement when student loans will open



You will need to apply for student loans on your own, we can show you where but not apply for you

If you wanted a specific program you should have applied in April!!



You can still apply but may be waitlisted.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



Go to the school you are interested in and look at admissions, it will tell you what you need for the program of interest.



Most NB universities require you to have 5 grade 12 courses and a specific average, it is listed on the admissions page.



Take some time and check to see what you need for a program of interest.

SCHOLARSHIPS / BURSARIES

Information can be found on university websites, look under admissions or financial aid



School website under guidance has a listing of scholarships to apply for, it will be updated shortly.



Generally need to write an essay when applying for a scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP ESSAYS, THINGS TO THINK ABOUT....

Scan items don't take pictures. (sometimes documents end up being very dark and organizations don't have time to respond to tell applicants the quality is too poor to read.)

Send the application to yourself first so you can see if it worked and you can open all the parts.

03

Answer all the questions provided, scholarships are scored on a rubric and if you're missing a section- you're not getting any points on that topic.

SCHOLARSHIPS CONTINUED.....

4 Proof-read: If you're applying for more than one be sure to take time to change the name of scholarship before you submit it.

5 Include real information reflecting your financial situation; how many children are in your family, how many children are currently in school, location of the school, how many years you expect to be in school, etc. Hardships like health issues, learning or physical disabilities can also influence the decisions.
