Notes:

- 1) English 11 is a full year course and comprises **two** of your ten choices.
- 2) **Five** French Immersion courses at the Grade 11 or 12 level are required for a French Immersion Certificate.
- 3) **Five** Grade 12 Credits are required for Graduation. These courses may be taken in either Grade 11 or 12.
- 4) Students can choose to take their one science credit required for graduation in either Grade 11 or 12
- 5) All students are enrolled in Growth Goals & Grit 120. This course, upon successful completion, will count as their required graduation credit in the category of Fine Arts and Life Role Development.
