DATES:

July 2nd – July 26th

ADMISSION: The Summer School program is offered to students of School District 6 and neighbouring districts. To enroll in Summer School, a student must have permission of his/her school Principal. In addition, students enrolled in summer school need a minimum mark during the school year of 50%.

COURSES: Students may enroll one or both courses.

FEES: The tuition fees for Grade 9, 10, 11, 12 English, Science and/or Math - \$200 for each course. Money orders should be made out to Sussex Regional High School.

DAILY SCHEDULE: To be determined

REFUNDS: A full refund of tuition fees will be issued by July 2nd if:

- Summer School is cancelled due to lack of registrations.
- A student cannot be timetabled.
- The course/courses in which a student has registered cannot be offered due to lack of registrations.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY:

The following shall be considered sufficient reason for requiring a student to withdraw from Summer School without refund of tuition fees:

- Aggressive, disruptive, disrespectful or other unruly behavior.
- Not working to his/her maximum.
- Absenteeism (for emergency, sickness, or approved absence only) greater than a total of two summer school days.
- Tardiness
- Failure to do assignments
- Truancy

TEXTBOOKS: Textbooks will be loaned to students for use during the Summer School. Students who lose or damage textbooks will be required to pay the replacement/repair cost before final marks are released.

EVALUATION: Student evaluations will be based on assignments, tests, and final exams.
