# What are the expectations in the Learning Commons?

The Learning Commons is a place to work quietly independently or collaborate in a group, using computers or pen and paper.

- The noise level should be appropriate (if I can hear you at my desk, you are too loud!)
- Check the board on the way in to see what side of the LC you should be sitting on (Lobby or Courtyard)
- The tables and chairs are arranged in a permanent place so please leave them where they are. If you move a chair to another table, move it back when you are done.
- Before you leave the LC make sure all chairs are pushed in and everything is picked up (garbage, paper etc)

#### More expectations....

Do not disturb others who are here working, its not a place to stop and visit during class time

The sign out sheet for the bathroom is on the table in front of my desk

Lastly, be respectful to everyone and everything – This space is a privilege to visit. It is used by the whole school and needs to be a safe, clean, useful space for all.

# Fire Drill & Lockdown Procedures

#### Fire drill – visiting with a teacher

- Go out the door, to the right, down the stairs and out the front door
- You then follow your teacher to their designated spot
- Fire drill visiting without a teacher
  - Go out the door, to the right, down the stairs and out the front door
  - You then follow me to my designated spot which is on the left side going down the main driveway
- Lockdown visiting with or without teacher
  - Interior or Exterior threat- you will go to the back room quickly and quietly.
     Lights off and have a seat.

# Visiting the LC with a Staff Member

- You sit where they would like you to
- If you are here to use a computer, you first must use the desktops
- Keep your voice level down
- This is an extension to your teacher's classroom; rules are to be followed

# Visiting the LC without a Staff Member

- A note must accompany you to the Learning Commons if not, you will be sent back to get one from your teacher
- You are here to work, so please do not disturb others that are here ot work

#### Borrowing Laptops

- You may borrow a laptop for one period at a time
- You must sign it out on the sign-out sheet on top of the laptop pod
  - Your name must be printed clearly as well as the teachers name, if not you will not be able to borrow one the next time (We need to know where they are at, at all times)
- When you are done using it, log out and shut it down properly if not done correctly, you will be asked to do it correctly before you leave.
  - Lower left corner log out
  - Wait until welcome screen comes on before hitting the power button
  - Wait until the light has gone out on the power button before closing the cover
- Sanitize the laptop when you are finished.9

## Using the LC Printer

- First and most important thing is that students are not to take things off the printer.
- You may print off school related work to the printer
- If you are using a school computer make sure you select "1818Library" as your destination
- If you want or need to print from your own device (phone, laptop, tablet) you will need to either email or share the file to myself or your teacher and we can print it for you.
