**protagonist:** house (technology)

**antagonist:** family / elements (nature)

**conflict**: technology vs. nature

**plot summary**: There has been a nuclear war, and everyone is dead. All that remains is one house in the entire city. Although the family is gone, the house (which is automated) carries on as though nothing has changed. Toward the end of the story a fire ignites inside the house, and the house is unable to control it. Only the rain manages to douse the fire, but it is too late. The house is destroyed.
