Not Just Black or White

Black, white, **Hispanic**, Asian, or Native American? These days, most people give credence to the idea that people can belong to more than one race. Those who have a black father and a white mother can identify themselves as either black or white—or both. A person can be Hispanic and Asian or Native American and European. When people call themselves multiracial, it means they honor and accept more than one ethnic group as part of their heritage.

Singer Mariah Carey's mother is white and Irish. Her father is black and Venezuelan. Actress Halle Berry, golf star Tiger Woods, and actor Keanu Reeves are all multiracial. Derek Jeter, the New York Yankees ballplayer, is multiracial, too. His father is African American, his mother is white and Irish.

Jeter remembers that some of his high school classmates were perplexed. White students thought he was black. Black students presumed he was white. Others would walk up to him and start speaking Spanish.

"I'm biracial," Jeter says. "People ask if I'm black or white. I'm both. I'm not one race."

Devon Sutherland, 13, faced myriad questions from classmates about his race. They would ask him in the cafeteria of his middle school in Montclair, New Jersey. "They're just confused," says Devon, who has a white mother and a black father.

At least two million multiracial people live in the United States today. There may be as many as six million. As that number grows, the idea that every person has to be of just one race is being **surpassed** by the multiracial concept.


"Not all people fit neatly into one little box," say Ramona Douglas. She leads a group that supports multiracial Americans. "People should have the choice to identify themselves as they **perceive** themselves, not as others do."

Jeter was asked which he would choose if he had the choice of being all black or all white. He said he would choose both. "I wouldn't change a thing. I have the best of both worlds."
