Audience: superintendent or Minister of Education or anyone responsible for making students make up snow days.

Thesis: Students in New Brunswick should not have to make up time missed because of snow days.

1.	There are still enough days in the school year to get the work done, even if a few days are missed.
2.	If the day were made longer, students would actually do worse in school.
3.	If the day were lengthened, teachers would not be able to keep up with their workload.
4.	The school day cannot be made longer without having a negative impact on out-of-school life.
