

SMS Expectations & Student Responsibilities

Dress Code

Students will dress in an appropriate manner for school. The dress code is also in effect for dances as well as extracurricular activities, sports, and school outings.

- Hats of any kind are to be removed when entering the school and are not to be worn inside the school. Hoods are treated as hats for the purpose of this dress code, and also must be removed when entering the school and are not to be worn inside the school.
- Clothing which would not be considered appropriate in a typical indoor work environment will not be permitted at school.
- No undergarments of any kind may be showing. Pyjamas are never appropriate for school.
- No clothing bearing inappropriate language or logos is permitted. This includes clothing that advertises beer, alcohol, or tobacco products, as well as clothing showing graphic violence, profanity, or language and/or designs which are offensive or discriminatory.

Electronic Devices / Cell Phones

- Students who choose to bring personal electronic items (such as cell phones, tablets, etc.) to school are responsible for their safekeeping and appropriate use in a school environment.
- **Cell phones are to be in lockers during class time.** They may be used at nutrition break and lunch time. If cell phones are used outside the proper time or inappropriately, they may be confiscated.
- Communication from home should be relayed through the school office. Students should not be contacted directly in class by cell phone since student cell phones are to be turned off during class time. Help your child follow expectations – please call the office.
- Capturing unsolicited images, audio or video recording not related to school activity and posting such items on the internet without permission violates Canadian privacy laws and will result in disciplinary measures and/or RCMP involvement.
