## <u>Emergency Response – F.A.Q.</u>

This past week a local high school experienced a LOCKDOWN due to the presence of a student carrying a deadly weapon. Here are a few important points about evacuations and lockdowns at RHS.

In the case of an **evacuation** students gather in three areas around the school and the principal takes advice from the fire department about the need for distance from the building. *Alternate evacuation site*: Should we be unable to re-enter the building or require further distance we move students to Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church. Families are asked to remain at home or at their workplace until they receive communication from the school about pick-up and/or transportation.


In the case of a **lockdown** students remain on the school site in locked classrooms until given the "all clear" by local police. Students are asked not to communicate using cellphones at this time to keep their location safe. Teachers will communicate using internal channels so that information can be shared with police. Again, in this situation families are advised to stay clear of the school until they receive communication about pick up and/or transportation.

We will be practising both a lockdown and a fire drill/evacuation this week. I will advise families via e-mail the morning of each drill.

### 41 School Days Remain – Including 5 days for Exams

We remain focused on ending the school year in positive learning environments.

- 1. Cellphones must be away, in the cell hotel or in bookbags, for a minimum of the first 30 minutes. They may only be used with express permission of the teacher.
- 2. Only one person may leave the classroom at a time, and they must leave their cellphone behind. They should be gone for a reasonable amount of time. Students will be given notes if they have permission to be out of class.



### Supporting Your Students @Home

*Q4 learning has begun (37 In Class Days)* Thank you for attending parent-teacher conferences and for engaging in conversation about student learning. With only 37 more in class days remaining, it is important that we assist our teens remain focused on finishing strong. Families are asked to.

- Maintain healthy eating and sleeping habits in the home.
- Reduce access to screens at least 1 hour before bedtimes to help promote healthy sleep.
- Create a study timetable for Grade 11 & 12 exams in June. Now is the time to begin organising notes, materials and seeking help at lunch or after school.


