- 1. In-School Learning 5 days a week** – a return to full attendance for all students is welcome news for all high school students and staff. We are looking forward to welcoming everyone back to the Nest!
- 2. Masks, Hand Sanitizing, and extra cleaning**– masks will still play a role in our Covid-19 safety protocols as will regular hand sanitizing and surface cleaning. Masks must be worn in common areas and on busses.
- 3. Limit to outside visitors.** We will have to limit outside visitors and large-scale events at the school. We anticipate hosting a virtual meet the teacher evening during the first two weeks of September – stay tuned!
- 4. Grade Level Assemblies Possible** – While we cannot meet as a full school, we can meet by grade level. We are looking forward to getting each grade together for cheer assemblies, pep rallies and more this year.
- 5. Teaching and Learning – Laptops, TEAMS & Exams**
 - **Laptops are here to stay** and if you have yet to order yours please follow this link – [LAPTOP SUBSIDY](#). Student use of cellphones during instructional time will be limited this year to promote better mental health.
 - **Microsoft TEAMS** will be our primary mechanism for instructional resources, communication with students. Students are expected to check their TEAMS app daily
 - **Exams will return in many of the Grade 11 & 12 courses that are pre-requisites for post-secondary studies.** Students will be receiving course syllabi (outlines) from their teachers in each class. These documents are a very important start to any course as they lay out what will be taught, how students will be evaluated/graded and how to access help from the teacher.

First Day & School Supplies

1. **SCHOOL PHOTOS** – Students will have their student ID and school photos taken on their first day of school. Students should dress accordingly. Our provider is Photography Flewelling.
2. **HOMEROOM.** Students will meet with their Homeroom teacher for a portion of the morning while we assign lockers, outline course change procedure, and gather paperwork that is to be sent home.
3. **SCHEDULES.** Students will receive their schedule and will visit all 5 classes on their first day to get a copy of the syllabus and meet their new teachers.
4. **SPIRIT ACTIVITIES & BBQ** – We will be hosting BBQs on the first days and activities on the front lawn & in the newly upgraded courtyard.
5. **SCHOOL SUPPLIES & FEES** – With laptops being the primary method for work submission and organization students will need limited school supplies. We gather a \$50 student fee to cover the locks, student activities, additional supplies for classrooms. Our recommendation is that students arrive on day one with;
 - a. Laptop & Charger
 - b. one binder with dividers & loose-leaf paper.
 - c. a small collection of pencils & pens
 - d. a scientific calculator for math classes.
