

BEHAVIOUR INTERVENTION POLICY

Stage 1: Issue develops in class

Consequence: Contact is made home by subject teacher to inform home of the situation

Stage 2: Issue is still occurring

Consequence: Subject teacher contacts home to inform the behaviour is still an issue in class. The administration is notified by the teacher and lunch detention is given.

Stage 3: Issue is still persistent

Consequence: Subject teacher informs administration. Administration will contact home to give after-school detention.

Stage 4: Issue is still persistent

Consequence: Subject teacher informs administration. Administration will contact home to organize a meeting with home to develop a plan.
