Positive Behaviour Expectations


Rather than writing out a long list of things that students can or cannot do at Rothesay High I feel that it makes most sense to list the 6 things that I feel all students should aspire to do daily. If students can read this list and state that they do these things daily, then I would feel as though we had done a good job at creating a learning environment that is safe and welcoming for all.

- 1. I will attend all my classes on a regular and punctual basis. This will include all assemblies and Homeroom.
- 2. I will be prepared for all my classes by bringing with me all necessary materials.
- 3. I will make a real and sustained effort in all my classes by participating in class, completing all assigned work and will work to the best of my ability.
- 4. I will show courtesy and respect for the teachers, support staff and other students at all times.
- 5. I will conduct myself in a manner the promotes a positive learning environment.
- 6. I will follow all school policies and rules as well as all reasonable directions of the administration and the staff.

Monday (during Homeroom) I will be addressing all 6 of these "I will" statements as I ask the students for help in keeping focused during the last 3 weeks of school in 2021 and in preparation for the final 3 weeks of Semester 2 in January 2022.

In addition, on Wednesday, we are going to review a lesson in our Homeroom classes on Intent versus Impact of our actions.

Through a good number of conversations with students, staff, and families this week it has become clear that we owe it to our students to better explain how our personal choices can impact others. The fundamental truth at the school level is that we are often dealing with the fallout from the impact of a student's actions rather than their intent and in the end if harm is an impact of their actions, then there may have to be consequences for those actions.

Considering some issues, I have dealt with over the past few months I thought that I would encourage families to discuss the importance of the following.

- "Pause before you post" many students report deep regret after
 rushing to post something that they found funny or an emotional
 response to a situation. Once the item is posted, even if the
 student later deletes it, it can live for a long time on other devices
 thanks to screen shots. One student error in posting can haunt
 them through their years of high school and beyond.
- Parent oversight on the contents of cellphones –I am encouraging
 that you sit together and view the images, posts, and other content
 that your teen shares/saves and discuss it together. These
 conversations help students learn the appropriate use of
 electronic content which could impact future post-secondary and
 career opportunities.
