Rothesay High School Re-Assessment/Exam Week Expectations

- Mandatory Attendance
- Arrive at 8:45 for a 9:00 start; 12:45 for a 1:00pm start
- Arrive with all materials needed for the class you are attending that day. (Pencils, pens, calculator, charged laptop, water etc.)
- When you are dismissed from your exam/re-assessment you may leave the building. The learning Commons, Cafeteria and the Gym will be open from 10:30-12:30 as areas to study quietly or get a little exercise before your period 2 class on **Monday only**.
- From 12:30-12:45 collect your supplies for your exam/re-assessment, washroom/drink etc. You are expected to remain in the classroom for the 1.5 hour time slot.
