This past week all students were given a presentation on course selection, and we hosted an information session for families. Wednesday March 23 we will host an extended HR class to enter the course selections into PS together. It is important that all students attend HR that day to ensure their course selections are entered correctly.

Important Information to Note:

- Course selection has a direct impact on the staffing and timetable of the building. Students requesting course changes in September will be limited due to the size of our school. Please take time to discuss these choices now
- We are offering far more Advanced Placement (AP) courses next year – we can do this as we are piloting blended classes across schools. We are working with Hampton, Fundy, and Simonds High Schools to offer more enrichment for all our students.
- Enrichment pathways begin in grade 10 and the best people to ask for advice are your current teachers. They know you best and give the most accurate information about the difficulty of the course.

- We can adjust schedules in June if students were unsuccessful in a pre-requisite
