


## Vaccination - Requirements & Opportunities

On Friday the Provincial Government and Department of Early Childhood and Education announced a few more changes for the school system considering the rising cases of COVID-19 in schools around the province;

#### Here is what you need to know;

- 1. Vaccines are now mandatory for students wishing to participate in extra-curricular activities (Sports, Clubs, SRC, Grad Class, etc). Students must show evidence of their fully vaccinated status (double vax) prior to participation in any ongoing meetings, practices & rehearsals. Here are the options for how to show proof;
  - Via e-mail to <u>Christina.Barrington@nbed.nb.ca</u>
  - In person at lunch in Mrs. Barrington's Office all week
  - Optional: If you would like us to keep a copy on file in the student's Cumulative Record we would be happy to do so.
- 2. Vaccination Clinic on site Tuesday Sept 21 (PM). Students wishing to get either their first or second dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine can register for this clinic by e-mailing <a href="mailto:Christina.Barrington@nbed.nb.ca">Christina.Barrington@nbed.nb.ca</a>
  - High school students may sign their own consent forms.
     Please inform your child if you do not want them to receive the vaccine.
  - Students should indicate their preference for Pfizer or Moderna
  - Those receiving their second shot are asked to bring the proof of the first vaccination.
  - Students must wait 28 days between doses.

## Supporting Your Students @Home

To get an understanding for what your student is studying you can do any of the following;

- Ask them to login to TEAMS and show you around the assignments tab, the ClassNotebook and the General Feed.
- Ask to see the course syllabus which will have details about what will be learned, how to get extra help and the breakdown for their calculated grade.
- Activate your ParentPortal & view your students' attendance and begin to navigate viewing their grades. Most teachers will start posting grades by Sept 30.
