It was so nice to see a number of our young children making their own marionette's during an indoor recess. It definitely demonstrates their engagement!
- We have had a number of grade 3 and 4 students (English Prime) move in to our serving area since we returned to school in January and are now beyond the maximum class size (as per Teacher Collective Agreement) at these grade levels. As a result, an additional class has been created and a new teacher has been hired. Effective March 13th, we will be reconfiguring the grade 3 and grade 4 classes and eliminating the grade 3½ combined class. The result will be two smaller grade 3 classes (of 18 or 19 students) and two smaller grade 4 classes of 20-21 students. Ms. Jennifer White has been hired as our second grade 3 teacher. She will join Mrs. Branch, Mr. Robichaud and Mrs. Creamer who will be teaching a straight grade 4 class. Ms. White is an experienced teacher who has taught all elementary grades. Last year she taught a 3½ split at

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Havelock school in Saint John. We recognize that a change at this point in the year is not easy on students but there are definite advantages to having smaller class sizes.
