- A letter was sent to all families from the Office of the Superintendent this week regarding **changes to busing to daycares starting in September 2016**. Below is a summary of the letter:

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March 14th-18th

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"Anglophone School District South has been reviewing the efficiency of the school bus transportation routes in the Kennebecasis Valley and have determined that they will need to make changes with respect to the transportation of children to afterschool programs. They will continue to transport children to afterschool care within the neighbourhood school zone but cannot continue to transport to afterschool facilities outside of their school zone. ASD-S has collected information from the afterschool providers to determine spaces available and numbers of children attending out of zone care. Based on the information collected, there should be enough spaces available at the afterschool providers polled located in each school zone. Majority of schools in the KV area are serviced by three or more afterschool providers, only K-Park has one provider. Afterschool providers located just outside of a school boundary, will only receive service from the nearby boundary if an existing bus route that starts within the boundary runs past the afterschool providers. There will be absolutely no changes to school zones, they will remain as is! "
