- Congrats again to our cast and crew of Lion King who performed beautifully at the regional Drama Fest this week!

-Our grade 2 students will complete a provincial literacy assessment between May 23rd and May 30th. Students will read passages that reflect the types and complexity of text outlined in the *Provincial Reading Achievement Standards (end of grade 2)*: Fiction (Realistic, Simple Animal, Fantasy, Folktales) and Nonfiction (Informational). Comprehension responses will include: literal (reading “the lines”), inferential/interpretive (reading “between the lines”), and personal/critical/evaluative (reading “beyond the lines”). Please reach out to your child’s teacher if you

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have any specific questions regarding this assessment. (There will not be a grade 4 assessment this year as the province needs to continue work on item development and refinement).

-A reminder that our current kindergarten students stay home on Friday, June 2nd to allow next year's students an opportunity to 'experience' kindergarten. This helps with the transition to school for our youngest learners.

-Thank you to all families who will be participating in our upcoming Gabriel Kuling Fun Run on June 3rd. We will have approximately 185 runners participating.
