Highlights -

85% of Grade 4 and 5 students eat breakfast
77% of Grade 4 and 5 students eat 5 servings of vegetables or fruit a day
17% say they've been bullied
96% have basic psychological needs met
41% spend more than 2 hours a day in front of a screen
54% exercise 60 minutes a day.

Interesting statistics from students who were in Grade 4 and 5 in the 2016-17 school year.
