

# Hello Families,

## Here are some ideas/activities to do while at home.

### Reading:

#### Sight Words:

- Review Grade One sight words (154 in total).
- The 38 Kindergarten sight words are included for those children who are working on mastering those.

#### **Activities to practice sight words:**

- Print sight words on recipe cards. Use these as flash cards
- Print sight words on popsicle sticks. Place popsicle sticks (words down) in a jar. Take turns with your child pulling out a popsicle stick and reading each sight word.
- Practice making sentences with the sight words. Example: (Can I come over and play?)
- Place sight words around your home. Go around the room and read words around the house.
- Practice printing sight words on white board (laminated piece of card stock)

#### Word Families:

-at, -an, -all, -op, -it, -in, -ot, -ill, -ug, -ake, -et, -ame, -eat, -ay, -ing, -ow, -ed, -ook, -ed, -oon, -ide, -ight, -ew, -en, -ink, -ar, -unk, -ack & -est

- Print rime portion of the word family (-at), cut up letters provided on cardstock. Make different words with these letters and word family chunks.
  - pan, fan, tan, san,
  - will, sill, fill
- Practice making word families on white board (laminated piece of card stock)

#### Read:

- Have children read 10 min/night
- Read to children

#### Printing Practice:

- All children need practice printing upper and lowercase letters

#### Writing:

Children can write about whatever they wish. They can draw a picture and then write about their picture. They should be encouraged to use uppercase letters at the beginning of a sentence, spaces between words, proper spelling of some sight words, and stretching out unfamiliar words.

**Math:**

**Numbers:**

- Print out and Cut up numbers 0-20 .
- Practice number ID
- Practice numbers putting numbers in sequence forwards and backwards
- Draw a card. What number comes before and after that specific number
- Practice skip counting
- Draw on a card, practice it showing it on the ten frames provided using cheerios or any other small objects
- Practice counting by 1's, 2's, 5s, 10s
- Refer when needed for number before & after

**Adding/Subtracting practice:**

- Practice doubles (1+1, 2+2 etc)
- Practice putting the larger in their hand and counting on

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**STARFALL** - Kindergarten section – All areas are good. **LEARN TO READ** (YES!- Easy stories with word families and sound chunks!) The other excellent section is the bottom 2 boxes under “I’m Reading” with the dragon. It has the word CAT with a gear and the hen holding the vowel letters. They concentrate on the vowel sounds. The “cat” gear page has children changing sounds in a word to create new words. The children love this one. The hen vowel page has several simple stories for your child to read that concentrates on specific vowel sounds.
