Math Matters - 100 Days of School

An interesting way to incorporate real math into school is to celebrate the 100th day of school. Our teachers incorporate the ideas into their daily activities. They begin with the first

day of school and end on the 100th day which usually falls mid February. This year the 100th day of school will be celebrated 2 during the week of February 15. The teaching opportunities prior to the actual day are endless. The children (depending on 25 grade) learn to count by ones, twos, fives, and tens. They learn 2 to use number lines and about tens and ones. As the 100th day 25 grows closer, so does the excitement. A variety of activities take place on the 100th Day; for example, students may do 100 Day projects, read 100 Day books, and participate in 100 Day crafts.





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
