- 26 students receiving direct support from Resource and Methods Teacher
- Levelled graphic texts (comics) ordered for Resource room
- All grade 2 students receive instruction from Literacy teacher in Word Choice trait (Salsa Words)
- All grade 1 students receive instruction from Literacy Teacher on writing the Super sentence and recount framework
- Hampton Huskies members read to students during Literacy Week
- 2 "Travelling Recounts" completed with all classrooms

- 12 male guest readers scheduled for Family Literacy Day
- Daily Bookworm Projects awarded daily
- Many volunteers continue to assist students with reading and writing
