 - 34 students currently receiving direct literacy intervention
 - Literacy Teachers provide classroom support to grade 2 classrooms
 - Scholastic Book Fair held
 - \$200.00 of new books purchased for school library
 - Each PLC receives \$200.00 for classroom books
 - MP3s purchased for Read to Self
 - Many volunteers helping students with reading and writing
 - Students complete letters to Santa (watch for them in Kings County Record)
 - Squirrel Hollow Post special Santa Letter edition to be published Dec. 8
 - Bookworm Award for student writing presented daily
 - 30 students receive direct resource support from Resource and Methods Teacher
 - 26 kindergarten students complete EYE-DA Intervention Program
 - School based team has met with District Psychologist and District Autism Specialists to review referrals
 - District Psychologist has completed 1 observation and report and is conducting observation of second student
