

Busing for Darlings Island Students if Road is Impassable

In previous years during any Darlings Island flooding events, the District provided a bus on the island side, in the morning, to pick up students and take them to the shuttle. The students then crossed on the shuttle and boarded Bus 705 on the mainland and were transported to school. The same service was offered (in reverse) in the afternoon.

Recently, it was announced that there will be **Emergency Shuttle Service only** provided to the residents of Darlings Island. However, ASD-S will have BUS 705 (driver John Allain) on the mainland side, providing transportation to and from the schools, if parents have a way to get their children to the bus, and would like to use the service.

If the road is impassable, and there is NO shuttle service, BUS 705 schedule will be as follows:

7:45 AM – Departing daily from the Community Center (or, from the nearest accessible point to the Center).

The driver will transport to and from the following schools, any Darlings Island bussing students who want to use the service.

- Dr.A.T.Leatherbarrow,
- Hampton Elementary,
- Hampton Middle, and
- Hampton High Schools),

2:10 PM – Drop off students at Community Centre (or, at the nearest accessible point to the Center)

3:05 PM – Drop off students at Community Centre (or, at the nearest accessible point to the Center)

3:55 PM – Drop off students at Community Centre (or, at the nearest accessible point to the Center)

As long as the road to Darlings Island remains open, regular school bus transportation will continue.
