



Information for students going into Grade 9

What happens in Grade 9?

Grade 9 is a set program. This means that students come to KVHS and follow a pre-set schedule based on their programming. Students that are in the English Prime program follow a course load that is all in English. Student in the French Immersion program follow a course load that is 50% in French and 50% in English.

What do I take in Grade 9?

The Grade 9 program of study is the following:

- English Language Arts 9
 - This course runs all year.
- Mathematics 9A and Mathematics 9B FI/FSL students take FI/FSL Mathematics 9
- Science 9
 - FI/FSL students take FI/FSL Science 9
 - This course is about Cells and Space.
- Social Studies 9
 - FI/FSL students take FI/FSL Social Studies 9.
 - This course is about Canada and the world.
- Personal Development and Career Planning 10 (PDCP 10)
 - FI/FSL students take FI/FSL PDCP 10
 - This is at the grade 10 level
- Post-Intensive French 9
 - FI/FSL students take FI/FSL Language Arts 9 (either Early or Late).
- Specialties.
 - You take a total of over 180 hours of specialties over the year.
 - Students take 45-hours of Broad-Based Technology, Health & Phys Ed, Music, and Visual Arts.

When do I get my schedule for Grade 9?

You will receive it on your first day of high school! Students at KVHS are looked after by a vice-principal and a guidance counsellor by their surnames, with Mrs. Poirier and Mrs. Walsh seeing students with last names A-G, Mr. Dobson and Mme. Stevens seeing students with last names H-M and Mr. Reid and Mrs. Price seeing students with last names N-Z.
