We can only accept a maximum of 52 students. We will reserve spots on a **“first come, first served”** basis. To reserve a spot, students will need to bring in the slip below, all accompanying forms, and pay the full balance of the skiing/snowboarding program by Thursday, December 7th. Cheques should be made out to Rothesay Park School. (All others will be put on a waiting list, and we will try to make alternate arrangements).

Once student participation is finalized, I will send home a notice with the cost for transportation. This could range between \$70 and \$120. Historically the transportation cost is around \$80. It is expected that if you’ve confirmed your spot by paying the first installment, you are committing to participating. I’m sorry to inconvenience you with the chore of making two separate payments, but without confirmed numbers, it’s difficult to accurately determine the additional cost for transportation.

TRANSPORTATION

The bus will leave RPS by 3:00 pm, mandatory lessons will take place from 4-5pm. Students will then have free skiing time from 5-8:15pm, we will board the bus at 8:30pm and should arrive back at RPS around 9:30pm. Return times will be dictated by weather, road conditions and departure times. Please be prepared to pick up your child at RPS by 9:30pm. Students will be encouraged to call parents when we are passing Hampton. The bus is provided by Optimum Ride. There is room for 52 students and 3 chaperones on the bus.

HELP

RPS is looking for a parent volunteer to drive his/her own vehicle and meet us at Poley. This volunteer would be responsible for any emergency trips. Lift tickets and rentals will be available for this chaperone at no cost, and his/her child(ren) can still travel on the bus if preferred. Please note – this is for the full six weeks.

We are also inviting any parents/guardians who are able to volunteer/chaperone once or twice over the 6-week program to join us. These volunteers could travel to Poley on the bus along with the teacher volunteers. Lift tickets and rentals will also be available.

EQUIPMENT

Poley Mountain Resorts Ltd provides rental equipment. Bindings on equipment reduce the risk of injury when falling. They will not release under all circumstances and they do not guarantee safety in all cases. Parents must accept responsibility for equipment that is lost or damaged (other than reasonable wear and tear.)

All participants must wear an appropriate Snow Sport Helmet for School Excursions at Poley Mountain Resorts Ltd. and may not, under any circumstances, Ski or Snowboard on a trail marked higher than a blue trail. All Mini Terrain Parks, Terrain Park and Terrain Park Features are off limits at all times to School Programs.

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

The Atlantic Ski Areas Association has produced a Responsibility Code which Poley Mountain Resorts Ltd requires that you know and obey. Skiers and Snowboarders must always be in control and be able to stop and change direction to avoid collisions with people or objects. *Poley Mountain Resorts Ltd. may revoke ski tickets for violation of the code or other unacceptable conduct.*
