Good morning,

With the availability of the COVID-19 vaccine for students this school year, some of the provincial COVID-19 guidelines have been updated. Vaccinated students are permitted to participate in more activities, they are not subject to self-isolation if they are a close contact to a confirmed case, and they would not participate in the new rapid testing program.

In the event that we have a confirmed case in our school community, knowing our students' vaccination status in advance greatly speeds up the contact tracing and rapid test process for Public Health.

For this reason, we are inviting families to volunteer your child's vaccination status with the main school office. If your child is vaccinated, we would NOT require a copy of any documentation. Once office staff is shown proof of full vaccination, documentation, or photo, we will only keep a record of 'yes' with respect to vaccination status. No other health information will be recorded. If your child has already shown it to the school for athletic teams/clubs, they do not need to show it again. If your child is not vaccinated, you may also confirm this information with the main office staff, and we will record them as 'no'. This information is collected for the purposes of outbreak management and athletic team/club participation only and will not be shared outside of Public Health or used for any other reason.
