## October Minutes

- Library- Everything is running smoothly. Regeena is printing off barcodes now. We are in need of more volunteers for certain classes. - I will look into the cost of a speaker system for the gym. Something mobile. SJBKE bought one 2 years ago. It was 2400 watt and \$1800. This is something we will try to purchase in the near future.
- Christmas concert. We will raffle off VIP tickets for front row seating and a prime parking space.
- We will ask for donations for the Christmas “themed baskets” earlier this year and sell tickets for longer.
- School clothing will be put off until after Christmas. I will look into dry weave t-shirts and long sleeve shirts, toques, hoodie (pullover and zip), and sweatpants.

- Babysitting night is a go! So far 21 people have shown interest. Now we need to secure volunteers and figure out a security system for drop off and pick up.
