As a warm-up to heritage fairs, Stamp Stories is New Brunswick's heritage design contest that students can enter. The top 8 entries will be posted on our website (<http://www.gnb.ca/Heritage/>)

A stamp design can be anything that students want it to be, as long as it has a New Brunswick history or heritage theme. It might be a local historic building or landmark, one of our ancestors, a cultural landscape, animal, favourite New Brunswick hero, important historical event — anything that means something special to the individual student.

How to Enter

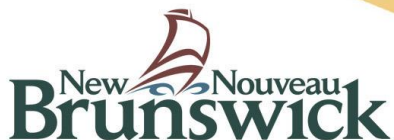
Draw the stamp design in the space provided on the entry form.
