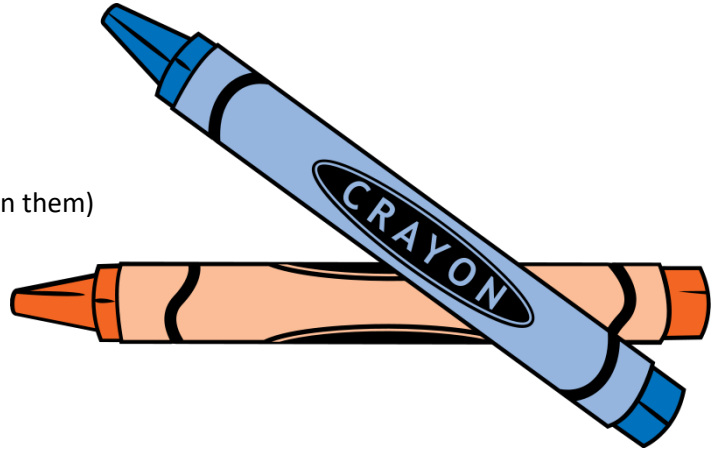


Princess Elizabeth School 2017-2018

Kindergarten Supplies:

PLEASE DO NOT PUT CHILD'S NAME ON SUPPLIES

- 4 containers of playdough
- 1 bottle of white glue
- 4 large glue sticks
- 4 duo tangs (same colour please – do **not** put names on them)
- 1 white eraser
- 1 pkg pencils
- 1 pkg wipes (unscented)
- 1 pkg construction paper
- School scissors
- Thick washable markers
- 48 crayons
- 2 boxes of tissue
- GIRLS – 1 box of **large** zip top plastic baggies
- BOYS – 1 box **small** zip top plastic baggies
- 1 small 72 page exercise book – green (blank at top for pictures) for journal writing
- 3 pkgs of dry erase markers (with erasers at end)
- 1 pencil box – not cases
- A complete set of play clothes to leave at school (including socks and underwear). Please put clothes in a bag with your child's name printed on the front.
- Inside sneakers



There will be a staggered entry for Kindergarten students this year and the process will be that half of the students will attend on September 6th and half on the 7th. All Kindergarten students will attend on September 8th. Your child's teacher will contact you the week before school begins to let you know when your child will start. We look forward to working with your child in September. Have a wonderful summer ☺

Here are some suggestions for help ensure your child's smooth transition from home to Kindergarten:

1. Please dress your child in comfortable clothes to encourage active participation.
2. If your child cannot tie laces, please send Velcro sneakers.
3. Make sure your child can open all snack containers you send to school.
4. Ensure that your child comes properly dressed for outside play as we will be going outside every day (weather permitting).
5. If your child is to be picked up by someone other than a parent, or if transportation arrangements have been changed, **it is very important to let me know either by a note or a phone call of this change. NO verbal messages from children.**
6. Explain to your child that there will be many things for him or her to do and use, but he or she will have to "take turns" and "share". If these terms are not familiar to your child, please demonstrate their meaning.

Supplies will be collected in September and distributed to children as needed. Glue sticks, tissue, and some other supplies may need to be replaced mid-year.

PES encourages the re-use and recycling of supplies from one year to the next. The above listed supplies do not need to be new; however, they do need to be in good condition.

In September, PES will be charging a \$10 student fee for Elementary students and a \$20 fee for middle school students, to a maximum of \$30 (K-8) for families with two or more students. These fees will go towards subsidizing enrichment activities for the students.
