

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

## Grade 8 Students: Laptop Subsidy Program

The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development Bring Your Own Device program is for students in grades 9 to 12. A laptop or tablet is a required tool to support learning in these grades. This program will allow for more personalized learning opportunities to help better prepare students for post-secondary education and the workplace. Under the program, parents and guardians can choose between purchasing a device and applying for reimbursement or applying for a subsidy code and ordering a laptop through IMP Solutions. Depending on your household income, your child could qualify for between \$200 to \$600 of subsidy.
