This is Greg Norton calling from PES to welcome you to our open house next week and highlight a few welcome back reminders for the week of Monday, Sept. 4<sup>th</sup> – Friday, Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>.

<u>PES Open House</u>: Our school open house is scheduled for the evening of Wednesday, Aug. 30<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 - 6:00. All are welcome to attend this drop-in event to meet your teachers, visit classrooms and ask any questions you may have. Students and parents can check the Homeroom listings in the main lobby and then see that HR teacher for more class schedule information. Students are also encouraged to drop-of school supplies the evening of the open house to lighten the load on their first day of school.

<u>Student Fees</u>: Student Fees are collected online at <<u>SchoolCashOnline.com</u>: <u>Welcome</u>> \$30 per child or \$50 for families with two or more children. (Student fees are broken down into the following categories: (1.) Activities/Fieldtrips; (2.) School Special Events; (3.) Athletics & Fine Arts; (4.) Awards & Student recognition).

<u>First Day for Kindergarten Students</u>: Kindergarten children will enter school through a staggered entry process with half of the students attending school on Tuesday, Sept. 5<sup>th</sup>, and half on Wednesday, Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>. Your child's Kindergarten teacher will be contacting you directly to inform you which day your child will attend.

First Day for Grades 1-5 Students: All Grades 1-5 students begin school on Tuesday, Sept. 5<sup>th</sup>.

First Day for Grade 6 Students: All Grade 6 students begin school on Tuesday, Sept. 5<sup>th</sup>.

First Day for Grades 7 & 8 Students: All Grades 7 & 8 students begin school on Wednesday, Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Thursday, Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>:** All students in Kindergarten – Grade 8 attend school on Thursday, Sept. 7<sup>th</sup>.
