| 1.        | Covid-19 Update                              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 54 students attending school in-person; PES one of few schools not asked to invite further at-risk students as they had brought in a sufficient number initially</li> <li>• Teachers have been able to meet in small groups or one-on-one, which has been a very big benefit to the students in attendance</li> <li>• Continuing on with student service meetings and with teacher performance meetings</li> <li>• School staff completed survey regarding various aspects of the PES school environment, practices, and administration – results were presented in a comprehensive report and was compared to district and provincial reports</li> </ul>  |
| 2.        | Perception Survey: PES & Comparative Results | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Areas of strength and items to continue working on were identified throughout the survey. Some items were on par/above average, some need improvement</li> <li>• Notable mention: 97% PES staff believe the school has high behavior expectations as compared to 77% in the district – bringing calmness to PES has been a major focus during this school year (good citizenship, respect, creating an inviting environment)</li> <li>• Notable mention: rated fairly low on parents feeling involved with the school               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sparked conversation regarding how school can try to involve parents more despite Covid restrictions</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Administration confident in the direction PES is heading and in the opportunities present for students and staff</li> </ul> |
